Statement 1 - Form 990, Part III, Line 4a - Statement of Organization's Program Service

Home Instruction for Parents of Preschool Youngsters (HIPPY) is a home-based early childhood education program that actively engages parents in teaching age and developmentally appropriate learning activities to their three and four year old children. Parent's As Teachers (PAT) is also a home-based early childhood education program that actively engages parents in teaching age and developmentally appropriate learning activities to their birth to two year old children. HIPPY and PAT recognize the important role parents play in their child's early learning experiences and provide in-home parenting support, as well as, parent group meetings that enable them to acquire needed skills, and confidence to teach their child. For the program year 2011/2012 there was a total of 237 children served by these programs.

Statement 2 - Form 990, Part III, Line 4b - Statement of Organization's Program Service

Jonesboro Urban Renewal and Housing Authority Housing Community Development Organization is a HUD-Approved Housing Counseling Agency that provides the following services: Mortgage Delinquency and Default Resolution Counseling, Fair Housing Assistance, Homebuyer Education Programs, Loss Mitigation, Money/Debt Management, Pre-Purchase Counseling, Post-Purchase Counseling, Predatory Lending and Renters Assistance counseling services.

We have served 372 clients with the following results. 104 clients completed Homebuyer Education workshops (8 hours) and received certificates that enabled them to access down-payments assistance programs in this area. 230 clients received pre-purchase one-on-one services that resulted in 70 clients becoming new homeowners, 20 mortgage ready within 90 days, 17 within 90-180 days, 106 receiving long term(>180 days) counseling, 8 clients decided not to purchase, and 6 withdrew from counseling. All of the clients who attended the workshops and received pre-purchase counseling received counseling in the area of budgeting, money management, and credit counseling services.

Statement 3 - Form 990, Part III, Line 4c - Statement of Organization's Program Service

CDBG funds are used in conjunction with the Housing Counseling Agency grant to serve the same client base and have the same goals and objectives. A Utility Assistance Grant was awarded to also to be used in conjunction with the Housing Counseling Agency to provide relief to clients in helping them with their utilities.
