 - Homeless Management Information Services The Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) is a computerized data collection tool specifically designed to capture client-level, system-wide information over time on the characteristics and services needs of men, women, and children experiencing homelessness HMIS allows the aggregation of client-level data across homeless service agencies to generate unduplicated counts and service patterns of clients served. The Coalition for the Homeless of Houston/Harris County (The Coalition) is the local HMIS lead agency. In the second quarter of 2012, there were 61 partner agencies participating in the HMIS with 141 programs and 398 active users. The HMIS data was used for the 2011 Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR), which was submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in January 2012 All reporting categories for the City of Houston's area coverage were submitted and accepted by HUD Provider agencies assisting clients with the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP), funded through the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, entered data in HMIS and sent quarterly reports to HUD Additionally, the VA-funded Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) programs started entering data in the HMIS and reporting out to the VA data repository. The key activity related to the Houston/Harris County HMIS during the 2011-12 operating year happened in the spring of 2012, when the Coalition participated in a HUD-sponsored HMIS Assessment project, conducted by Abt Associates. The Assessment concluded that the Coalition's HMIS has "good data quality and fair coverage rates for CoC homeless programs", and it set forth a number of recommendations about the CoC governance data quality coverage and participation capacity, proyects and security, and meeting of future. number of recommendations about the CoC governance, data quality, coverage and participation, capacity, privacy and security, and meeting of future requirements. The HMIS Assessment summary states. "Overall, the Houston HMIS is managed consistent with current HUD HMIS Standards, and is well positioned to fully implement the new HEARTH Act requirements and to support the ability of the CoC to meet the new HEARTH performance reporting."

Lead Agency Support Point in Time Count - In January, the Coalition led the community's effort to obtain a one-night count of the homeless in the Houston / Harris County Continuum of Care (the CoC) An Enhanced Point in Time Count Methodology was developed based on the approved observational count model and complete canvassing of the region. Volunteer participation in the count increased from 350 in 2011 to 450 in 2012. 29 separate study areas in the CoC region were canvassed. Nine staging areas were utilized. The model was accepted for presentation as a best practice at the Texas Conference on Ending Homelessness in September 2012 The study concluded that there was a 15% decrease in the homeless population from the 2011 Homeless Count The Coalition simultaneously conducted a Community Needs Assessment which successfully researched the triggers to homelessness. In addition, a needs assessment inventory was utilized by providers to leverage funding opportunities Charrette - The Coalition led a community Charrette planning process to advance the CoC's ten year plan to prevent and end homelessness. A representative 15 member steering committee was selected at the May launch of the Charrette process. Four community input meetings were held in June 2012 to determine the major focus areas of the Charrette Participation included over 80 consumers and over 150 other diverse stakeholders. The Charrette Study guide was drafted accordingly and 36 experts both local and national were secured to conduct fishbowl community input sessions during Charrette week August of 2012 Over 450 persons participated in the Charrette which produced a community accepted action plan report and community priorities Homeless Services Coordinating Council (HSCC) - The Homeless Services Coordinating Council convened for monthly meetings with average attendance of 80 stakeholders The Coordinating Council gave input on the governance structure of the Continuum of Care and created a process to elect two provider representatives to the CoC Steering Committee with one representing the crisis system and the other representing permanent supportive housing. Coordinating Council members also created priority recommendations for the CoC grant and regular input the HUD priority Community Work Plan. HSCC members also completed the CoC checkup in fall of 2011 which led to the designation of HUD priority community Consumer Advisory Council (CAC) - The Consumer Advisory Council met on the fourth Friday monthly and gave valued consumer input to the CoC. The Council is staffed by the Coalition Community Engagement staff. Elections were held in April 2012. The CAC successfully hosted a June Consumer input forum for the Charrette with over 80 consumers giving input. Additionally, the CAC hosted a focus group that gave valued input to the City of Houston Charitable Food Services Ordinance Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH). The Coalition helped secure and save funding for permanent supportive housing (PSH) projects in the Houston area by encouraging area agencies to cooperate and created a plan for better utilization of federal government resources. The Coalition planned and conducted 6 PSH workshops in partnership with the Corporation for Supportive Housing. As of the close of fiscal 2011-2012 plans were being made to develop a new and thorough permanent supportive housing plan for the Houston CoC Continuum of Care Collaborative Grant Application - The Coalition is the Lead Agency for the Continuum of Care (CoC) Homeless Assistance Grant application released by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development The application process involves a set of three competitively-awarded grant programs created to address the problems of homelessness in a comprehensive manner. Those programs include, Supportive Housing Program (SHP), Shelter Plus Care (S+C) and Single Room Occupancy (SRO). When HUD publishes a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance in the Federal Register, applicants must submit specific information. about a proposed project, along with their Continuum of Care application. The Coalition is responsible for notifying existing grantees and potential grantees of funds availability and educating them on the application process Once new grant applications are submitted, a public hearing is held so that each applicant who wants to submit for a new grant is given an opportunity to describe their program to the selection committee, which reads and ranks each new submission. The highest scored applications are selected for submission to HUD. Coalition staff then completes a review of each selected application and recommends corrections and (esnaps) and submitted to HUD Once all applications are reviewed, applications are entered into HUD's electronic application and grants management system (esnaps) and submitted to HUD HUD later notifies grantees of the outcome Homeless Memoriam - On the longest right of the year, Friday, December 21, over 500 Houstonians gathered on the steps of City Hall to honor the lives of those homeless who died in 2012. The Coalition for the Homeless of Houston and Harris County remembers those members of our community, some of whom have lived on the streets, by reading aloud each person's name at a candlelight vigil. Before the vigil, volunteers from the Coalition and local homeless service providers served a hot meal to over 500 persons living on our streets. The Coalition also distributed hygiene kits, coats, blankets to all 500

Homeless Services Information and Referral - In September 2011, United Way 2-1-1 Texas Connect was awarded a grant that dictated collaboration between the Coalition and the United Way referral system including a Continuous Quality Improvement Work plan. The collaboration resulted in greater data set analysis for the homeless residential system, better inclusion in the community information and referral system by homeless providers, and enhanced reporting of gaps on the referrals 6,396 unduplicated calls were received for the fiscal year of 2011 - 2012 Homeless Court - Homeless Court (HC) is a special Court session for homeless defendants to resolve outstanding misdemeanor offenses and warrants within the City of Houston's Municipal Courts. HC builds on partnerships between the court, local shelters, and service agencies. It works to resolve the problems that homelessness presents with practical solutions. Initial referrals to HC originate in shelters and service agencies. Referrals are submitted to the Coalition for the Homeless of Houston/Harris County. Court staff pulls dockets, and court dates are set by the presiding judge. HC is designed for efficiency. From July 2011 thru June 2012, 539 clients (defendants) cleared 2,096 cases with the city of Houston. Community. Voice Mail provides free voice mail service to people without phones seeking jobs, housing, health care, safety and stability. The Coalition offers this program to enable phoneless people to communicate with potential employers, landlords and human service providers. Between July 2011 and June 2012 CVM served 3,175 people thru 120 human service providers. Average number of clients added monthly was 264–61% were unemployed with 46% reporting no financial resources. 77% found employment, 81% found housing, 92% obtained healthcare and 94% connected to social services.
