NOTE 1 ORGANIZATION

THE JULIO A. MARTINEZ MEMORIAL FUND (the Organization) was organized in the State of New York in March 2003 under the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law. It is exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Organization is affiliated with BASICS, Inc., Promesa, Inc. and Acacia Network Housing, Inc. and provides services to New York children.

NOTE 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

FINANCIAL STATEMENT PRESENTATION

Net assets, revenues, expenses, gains and losses are classified based on the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions. Accordingly, net assets of the Organization and changes therein are classified and reported as follows: <u>Unrestricted Net Assets-Net Assets</u> that are not subject to donor-imposed stipulations. Unrestricted net assets consist of investments and otherwise unrestricted amounts that are available for use in carrying out the objectives of the Organization and include those expendable resources which have been designated for special use by the Board of Directors. None of the Organization's net assets are subject to donor-imposed restrictions.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, and the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities, at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

For purposes of the statement of cash flows, the Organization considers all highly liquid investment instruments with a maturity of three months or less are considered to be cash equivalents. As of June 30, 2012, there were no cash equivalents.

NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

INCOME TAXES

The Organization is a federal tax exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, therefore no federal tax is accrued or paid. The Organization's Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax, is subject to examination by the IRS, generally for three years after it is filed.

NOTE 3 - PLEDGES RECEIVABLE

Pledges receivable represents amounts pledged to the Organization as of June 30, 2012.

NOTE 4 - SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

Subsequent events have been evaluated through April 16, 2013, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
