Clients met with a caseworker, who evaluates their needs and attempts to solve them via referrals, direct payments to vendors, visits to our food bank, or financial advice and budgeting assistance. The Basic Needs Program includes our food bank in Boulder, our furniture donations/distribution program, and basic needs offices in Boulder, Lafayette, and Broomfield.  EFAA provided \$691,559 in direct financial assistance for rent, utilities, transportation, emergency motel shelter, minor medical and dental needs, and miscellaneous in FY12. Our food bank distributed 746,547 pounds of food to over 2,830 households; we value
	this food at \$1.69 per pound, so this amounted to \$1,261,664.

	Emergency Shelter Program - Families which are are homeless or nearly so when we encounter them are housed in one of our
	shelter units for up to three months During their stay, we provide all living expenses and safeguard the clients' income for them so
	when they leave they have savings to arrange for housing. Some of our emergency client families are accepted into our Transitional
	Housing Program. Emergency shelter clients meet with a caseworker at least weekly.  Transitional Housing Program - Families are housed in one of our transitional housing units for up to two years. During their stay,
	they pay a security deposit and below-market rent. Ideally, when they move out, they have saved enough to secure more permanent
	housing solution, and have experienced success at being good tenants.
	EFAA has 57 units of shelter and housing in Boulder, Lafayette, Longmont, and Louisville In FY12 we served 126 households
	representing 437 individuals. 88% of families leaving these programs found affordable housing, considered a successful outcome.
