**SERTOMA Club of Littleton** Part I Line 10 and Part III Line 31 In addition to the three organizations described in Part III lines 28, 29 and 30, the Club gave amounts to the following organizations; AG Beli \$1,100, Marion Downs Hearing Center \$1,100, Listen Foundation \$1,100, SERTOMA, Inc. Foundation \$975, North Littleton Promise \$900, Inter Faith Community Service \$1,000, Special Olympics \$450, Soap Box Derby \$1,000, Wounded Soldiers Fund \$750, Western Welcome Week \$625, CHARG \$800, Arapahoe Rescue Patrol \$1,000 Littleton Meals on Wheels \$1,500, Arapahoe High School Choir \$250, Highline Y \$500, Freedom Week activities \$542. There was a total of \$18,642 given out, we estimate that about 40% of that was for hearing and speech health. In addition to giving money to various organizations, the Club also participates in various community projects and organizations on a volunteer basis. For example Members of the Club deliver meals for the Littleton Meals on Wheels every Wednesday. We also participate in the local Santa Clause Shop, that benefits children in need, by arranging for and distributing donation boxes at various businesses. Then club members pick up donations at those businesses two or three times a week. This activity runs from early November through Christmas. The Freedom week activities that take place on Presidents Day in February is the culmination of a series of activities by Club Members. These activities include going to local middle schools, speaking with teachers about having students write essays about what "Freedom Means to Me" then club members must read all of the essays and decide on a winner from each school. This is an area wide activity which includes all of the SERTOMA Clubs in the area. Club Members also participate in community beatification programs by planting trees in local and State Parks. These are just some examples, the Club and it's members participate in many other community out reach programs. Part I Line 16 Total of other expenses amounted to \$11,985. This amount is made up of the cost of having the meetings on the 1st 3rd and 5th Fridays of a month \$7,837. Dues and insurance paid to parent organizations \$2,784. Annual Installation dinner and Holiday party and miscellaneous business expenses like postage and Post Office Box, paper, ink, envelopes, etc. \$1,364. Part II Line 24 The other assets consist of Grocery Store Coupons that we sell to members and other SERTOMA Clubs. The club receives about 5% when sold to Club Members, however, we sell to other Clubs at our cost. The net proceeds of this activity helps pay for Club operating expenses. The inventory of Grocery Coupons was \$6,742. The other \$525 paid during FY 2011 for a Fund raiser that takes place in August 2012. (I am aware that this is not strictly cash accounting, but I think that the matching of revenue and expenses to their respective events was

important in this cases.)
