	Community Living Services Marc Centers Community Living Services saved taxpayers approximately 6,857,325 in one year compared to the cost of Arizonas ICF/MR facilities 100 of those receiving services expressed satisfaction with the quality of programs. Individuals served recognize their residence as their home and have chosen to live with us on average for 11.5 years. 100 of individuals experienced a progressive move or maintained residency in the most optimal setting during the program year. The individuals with a serious mental illness served by Marc Centers residential programs remained in their communities. Only 5 had to be hospitalized for mental illness in the past year. The Community Living Services Department remains in high compliance with all applied rules and statutes receiving an overall 97 compliance ratio.

Stated differently, for every dollar invested in rehabilitation, individuals with disabilities returned 7 in taxes once gainfully employed.
