Property and Asset management - The Primavera Foundation owns sixteen properties which include three office buildings, two shelters with 108 beds and 17 units, and eleven multifamily transiitonal and permanent rental properties with 129 units in various neighborhoods in the community. Valued at approximately \$4,000,000, all properties are 100% owned without any amortizing debt. Two properties have small rehab HOME loans. Primavera's goal in developing and offering rental housing is to ensure that people have fair access to safe and affordable housing, as well as the supports necessary to achieve their maximum potential for self-sufficiency. The majority of tenants fall into the 50% of Area Median Income bracket or below. This business line is responsible for the management and maintenance of all rental and office properties.
