Monies collected from corporate tax credit contributions are directed towards students entering their first year of private education, whether as new kindergarten students or as public school transfer students, as long as the student meets the low-income threshold prescribed by the State of Arizona. To be financially qualified to receive an award, the family's income may not exceed 185 percent of the income limit required to qualify for the Federal free and reduced lunch program.
