The conversation centers on whether the person with a conflict will participate in the discussion and/or the decision. Once a fair process is determined in keeping with the policy, then a group decision is made. The matter is recorded in the minutes of the meeting.

Committee of the board completes an employee review of the Executive

Director. The review process is managed by the Vice-President. A

comprehensive review document is used that involves a report on results of
the prior period by the employee followed by an assessment by the Executive

In circumstances where the Executive Committee believes that a change in compensation is appropriate, it is first determined whether there is capacity in the budget to make any increase. Then, the Executive Committee uses salary data gathered from local sources and the Council on
