#### I. NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be Kahuku Development Foundation, Inc.

## II. MAILING ADDRESS

The mailing address of the Corporation shall be PO Box 174, Kaneohe, HI 96744.

## III. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE; INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The name of the Corporation's registered agent in the State of Hawaii is Joseph Pickard. The street address of the Corporation's registered office is 47-433 Hui lo Street, Kaneohe, HI 96744.

## IV. PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of the Corporation's duration is perpetual.

### V. PURPOSE AND POWERS

This Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation within the meaning of Chapter 414D of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The Corporation is organized for the following specific proposes and powers:

- (a) To provide attractive, decent, safe, and sanitary housing for needy individuals; and
- (b) To serve as a catalyst in the community among groups which could assist in meeting the need for such housing; and
- (c) To provide, with professional staff, under policy guidance by the Corporation, assistance to prospective sponsors of projects providing housing for needy people, utilizing government and other programs; and
- (d) To provide or contract for management services for housing projects for needy individuals; and
- (e) To assist public and not-for-profit entities to meet the needs of rural communities, including housing, utility infrastructure, health, sanitation and safety, education, and employment; and
- (f) To have and exercise all of the powers conferred by law on nonprofit corporations;

provided, however, that the foregoing shall be strictly limited to charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions for any subsequent federal tax laws (the "Internal Revenue Services"). The Corporation is not organized for profit and it will not issue any stock. No part of its assets, income or earnings shall be distributed to any Director, Officer, employee or any private individual, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation effecting one or more of its objects and purposes or for reimbursement of expenses incurred in behalf of the Corporation. No Director, Officer or employee of the Corporation, or any private individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the Corporation's assets on dissolution of the Corporation. No part of the activities of the Corporation shall include (i) carrying on propaganda, (ii) attempting in any manner to influence legislation, except that members of the Corporation's Board of Directors and personnel of the Corporation may testify or make other appropriate communications where formally requested to do so by a legislative body or a committee or a member thereof in matters concerning legislation relating to the public purposes of the Corporation or public appropriations to programs and activities of the Corporation, or (iii) participating or

intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), or contributing to, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductable under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

#### VI MEMBERS

The Corporation shall not have any Members.

### VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors, which shall consist of not less than three (3) members. The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected or appointed at such times, in such manner and for such terms as may be prescribed in the Bylaws.

## VIII APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS

The number of Directors constituting the Board of Directors shall be three (3).

The following persons shall act as the Directors of the Corporation until their successors are duly elected or appointed as provided by the Bylaws.

# IX. DIRECTOR CONFLICT OF INTEREST

No contract or other transaction between the Corporation and one or more of its Directors or any other corporation, firm, association or entity in which one or more of its directors are directors or officers, or are financially interested, shall be either void or voidable because of the relationship or interest or because the Director or Directors are present at the meeting of the Board of Directors or a committee thereof which

authorizes, approves or ratifles the contract or transaction or because the vote of the interested Director or Directors are count for that purpose, if:

- (a) The material facts of the transaction and the Director's relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Board of Directors or committee which authorizes, approves or ratifies the contract or transaction by a vote or consent sufficient for the purpose without counting the votes or consents of the interested Director or Directors; or
- (b) The contract or transaction is fair and reasonable to the Corporation at the time it is entered into.

# X. INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS

(a) As used in this Article, unless the context otherwise requires:

"Agent" means any person who is a or was a Director, Officer, employee or other agent of the Corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another foreign or domestic business or nonprofit corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or other enterprise, or was a director, officer, employee or agent of a foreign or domestic corporation which was predecessor corporation of the Corporation or of another enterprise at the request of the predecessor corporation.

"Expenses" include, without limitation, attorney's fees and any expenses of a completed action or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative.

The Corporation shall have power to indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any proceeding (other than an action by or in the right of the Corporation or where the person was found liable on the basis of his improper receipt of personal benefit) by reason of the fact that the person is or was an agent of the Corporation against expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees). judgments, fines, settlements and other amounts actually and reasonably incurred in connection with such proceeding if the person acted in good faith and in a manner the person reasonably believed to (1) be in or not opposed to the best interest of the Corporation if the person was acting in an official capacity; or (2) in all other cases, at a minimum, did not oppose Corporation's best interest; and with respect to any criminal proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe the conduct of the person was unlawful. A director's conduct with respect to an employee benefit plan for a purpose the director reasonably believed to be in the best interests of the participants in and beneficiaries of the plan is conduct that satisfies the requirements of subparagraph (2) hereof. The termination of any proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction or upon a plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent is not, of itself, determinative of the person's failure to meet the standard of conduct described herein.

- (c) The Corporation shall have the power to indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action by or in the right of the Corporation to procure a judgment in its favor by reason of the fact that the person is or was an agent of the Corporation against expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) actually and reasonably incurred by the person in connection with the defense or settlement of such action if the person acted in good faith and in a manner the person reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the best interests of the Corporation. No indemnification shall be made in respect of any claim, issue or matter as to which the person shall have been adjudged to be liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of the person's duty to the Corporation unless and only to the extent that the court in which the action or suit was brought shall determine upon application that, despite the adjudication of liability but in view of all circumstances of the case, the person is fairly and reasonably entitled to indemnity for such expenses as the court shall deep proper.
- (d) To the extent that an agent has been successful on the merits or otherwise in defense of proceeding referred to in subsection (b) or (c), or in defense of any claim, issue or mater therein, the agent shall be indemnified by the Corporation against expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) actually and reasonably incurred by the agent in connection therewith.
- (e) Any indemnification under subsection (b) or (c) of this Article shall be made by the Corporation only as authorized in the specific case upon a determination that indemnification of the agent is proper in the circumstances because the agent has met the applicable standard of conduct set forth in subsection (b) or (c). The determination shall be made (1) the Board of Directors by a majority vote of a quorum consisting of Directors who where not at the time parties to the proceeding; or (2) majority vote of a committee duly designated by the board consisting of two or more Directors not at the time parties of the proceeding, if a quorum is not obtainable; or (3) independent legal counsel selected by (1) or (2); or (4) the full Board of Directors if a quorum cannot be obtained under (1) or a committee appointed under (2); or (5) the court in which the proceeding is or was pending upon application made by the agent.
- (f) Expenses incurred in defending any proceeding may be paid by the Corporation in advance of the final disposition of the proceeding upon (1) receipt of a written affirmation of the person's good faith belief that he has met the applicable standard of conduct under subsection (b) or (c) of this Article; (2) receipt of a written undertaking by or on behalf of the person to repay such amount if it shall ultimately be determined that the person did not meet the applicable standard of conduct; and (3) the Corporation making a determination that the facts then known would not preclude indemnification.
- (g) The indemnification provided by this Article is not exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any Bylaw, agreement, vote of disinterested Directors or otherwise, both as to action in a person's official capacity and as to action in another capacity while holding office, and shall continue as to a person

who has ceased to be an agent and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs and personal representatives of such a person.

- (h) The Corporation shall have the power to purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any agent of the Corporation against any liability asserted against or incurred by the agent in any such capacity or arising out of the agent's status as such, whether or not the Corporation would have the power to indemnify him against such liability under the provisions of this Article. Any such insurance may be procured from any insurance company designated by the Board of Directors, including any insurance company in which the Corporation shall have any equity or other interest through stock ownership or otherwise.
- (i) This Article does not apply to any proceeding against any investment manager or other fiduciary of an employee benefit plan in such person's capacity, though such person may also be an agent of the employer corporation as defined in subsection (a). Nothing contained in this Article shall limit any right to indemnification to which a trustee, investment manager or other fiduciary may be entitled by contract or otherwise.

### XI. DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of the Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and/or scientific purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

### XII. Bylaws

The initial Bylaws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors. The Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed, and new Bylaws may be adopted, by the Board of Directors as prescribed in the Bylaws.

### XII. DEFINITIONS

The word "person" or any pronoun used in place thereof, where the context so requires or admits, shall include and mean individuals, firms, corporations, partnerships and associations. The singular shall include and mean the plural, or vice versa. Masculine, feminine and neuter genders shall include or interchange each of the other genders as the context shall imply.
