EOC IS A CO-DEFENDANT WITH TWO OTHER ORGANIZTIONS AS A PAST MEMBER OF A MULTIPLE EMPLOYER HEALTH AND WELFARE FUND, THE "FUND", ESTABLISHED FOR THE BENEFIT OF EMPLOYEES OF COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCIES AND THEIR FAMILIES. PLAINTIFFS, A FORMER PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER IN THE HEALTH AND WELFARE FUND, SUCEEDED IN OBTAINING A JUDGMENT AGAINST THE "FUND" IN AN EARLIER ACTION TO WHICH EOC WAS NOT A PARTY AFTER FAILING TO COLLECT ON THE JUDGMENT, SINCE THE "FUND" IS NOT IN BUSINESS, PLAINTIFFS BROUGHT THE PRESENT ACTION AGAINST THE REMAINING PARTICIPATING AGENCIES. DAMAGES WERE ASSESSED AGAINST ALL DEFENDENTS IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$1,393,720, INCLUSIVE OF ATTORNEY'S FEES. AND JUDGMENT HAS BEEN ENTERED IN THAT AMOUNT, APPORTIONED AGAINST EOC IN THE PRINCIPAL SUM OF \$1,143,006. BY THE PRESIDING JUDGE'S DECISION DATED MARCH 13, 2013, THE JUDMENT WAS AFFIRMED BY ALL RESPECTS, BY THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE SECOND CIRCUIT. IN ACCORDANCE WITH U.S. GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES, EOC HAS ACCRUED FOR THE FULL LITIGATION OBLIGATION BECAUSE, AT THE DATE THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS WERE AVAILABLE TO BE ISSUED, THE LOSS CONTINGENCY IS BOTH PROBABLE AND REASONABLY ESTIMATABLE MANAGEMENT AND LEGAL COUNSEL OF EOC ARE STILL EXPLORING ALTERNATIVE MEASURES TO MITIGATE THE DAMAGES THAT BEEN ASSESSED
