WITH AN ENROLLMENT OF 770 STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE TWELVE, THE SCHOOL SEEKS TO ATTRACT STUDENTS WHO REFLECT THE ETHNIC DIVERSITY OF LOS ANGELES BUCKLEY'S EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY.
