At capacity, CityTeam fills over 450 beds in cities across the nation offering a safe, warm and accepting environment where the poor and broken can find food, shelter, safety, counseling and peer-based spiritual transformation. The facilities allow them time and space to discover physical, social, emotional, intellectual and spiritual recovery and life transformation.

	CityTeam operates in scores of neighborhoods through training networks of local volunteer leaders. CityTeam resources community leade with food boxes, clothing, household items, furniture, Christmas toys and back to school supplies to help families overcome hardship and break out of the cycle of poverty. Through acts of compassion, emotional and spiritual encouragement and training, locally led communities of faith are emerging.
