However, the Fleet is subject to Federal income tax on its unrelated trade or business income of \$1,000 or more. Interest income was below \$1,000 for 2012. Interest income of \$100 was taxable for 2011. The Fleet regularly reviews and evaluates its tax position taken in previously filed information returns

and as reflected in its financial statements, with regard to issues affecting its tax exempt status, the event of an examination by taxing authorities, its position would prevail based upon technical merit of such positions. Therefore, the Fleet has concluded that no tax benefits or liabilities are required to be recognized with the exception of interest income and the credit for small employer health insurance premiums.

There was no excise tax on investment income for 2012, the excise tax was \$4 for 2011. The credit for small employer health insurance premiums was \$957 and \$1064 for 2012 and 2011 respectively. Related health insurance expense was reduced by the amount of the credit.

The Northeast Harbor Fleet tax returns are subject to federal and state review by taxing authorities for the fiscal years ending September 30, 2010, 2011 and 2012.
