More than 77 scholars are matriculating through the program Scholars are annually awarded a four-year renewable scholarship up to \$2,000 for the term. To qualify, students must demonstrate outstanding academic achievement, financial need and a commitment to community. Funding tuition is just one of the many hundles facing first-generation college students. Many are leaving home for the first time, attempting to juggle work and class while scraping together enough money for books and other supplies. Virtually 90% of our scholars are first-generation college students, navigating through college on their own. EWSP is an incredible support network that includes adms sions counseling, dedicated mentors, specialized internships, financial assistance and professional workshops for each scholar accepted into the program. Workshops include resume-wirting, mock interviews, information about graduate school and beginning the career search. It is important to underscore that Scholars receive. TWF financial assistance for tuition, books, and travel home as well as for TWF workshops and winter clothing. Another aspect of the EWSP are pre-college workshops designed to get young people to understand that it is not too early to start thinking about college and the benefits of a college education. The workshops are designed to help students finish high school prepared for postsecondary e ducation and with a clear idea on how to best approach the applic
