**Part I: Line 10 - Grants and similar accounts paid**

The total spent on programs to support orphans and vulnerable children was \$80,210. Of this, \$13,717 was spent on what we call "Level 1" support for 29 children. Their school fees, uniforms and materials were purchased so they could attend the local public school. "Level 2" funding is for students to attend a local private school, which is more expensive. We spent a total of 13,100 to cover 8 children at this level. "Level 3" is for technical schooling. We spent \$14,787 to send 5 children to motor mechanics, dress making and secretarial schools. "Level 4" funding is for students who attend boarding schools. We have 4 children at this level and spent \$6,446 on their fees, uniforms, and supplies. "Level 5" is university funding. This typically covers room and board, transport, supplies, and school fees. We have 8 students who receive full or partial support for university, totaling \$22,085. In addition, \$8553 was spent on extra lessons, school trips, awards recognition dinners, sports/camps for children being funded. And \$1521 was spent for the children's health and medical needs.

**Part I: Line 16 - Other expenses**

Because all of our programs run in Zimbabwe, we have to make international wire transfers. In total, we spent \$609 on bank/Paypal fees, \$100 on fees related to the Internet and phone, & \$415 on office supplies. Another \$429 was spent on fees from Western Union/MoneyGram and extraneous expenses that do not fall under programming or fundraising. Finally, \$4,317 was spent on travel to and from Zimbabwe by two board members to check on programs(\$3,590), travel expenses while in Zimbabwe (\$690) and food for board meetings (\$36).

**Changes to 2011 Amended form:**

990-EZ: Part I – lines 1 and 9. The total raised was \$113,710 and not \$113,003.

990-EZ: Part I - Line 10 and line 13. On the original form I included \$27,575 under line 13, but this spending was for transportation and programming costs that should really have been part of the overall programming spending. The amount has not changed but I moved it to line 10 and broke down how it was used in Part III lines 28-31.

990-EZ: Part I – line 18. This amount changed when line 9 changed. The correct amount is -\$714, not -\$1,421.

support percentage has not been changed much. Instead of the 68% that was listed, it's 74%
