NOTE B - CONTRIBUTIONS AND SPONSORSHIPS

Through September 30, 2012, 1) has committed \$17,600,000 to the Organization as part of a planned series of challenge grants totaling \$34,600,000. 1______ 3 support requires achieving specific operational benchmarks and results over five years to ensure the project's success. As of September 30, 2012, the Organization has not met the conditions for the remaining payments, which are considered conditional promises to receive and will be recorded in the financial statements when the conditions are substantially met.

As part of the challenge grant, in December 2011 and December 2010, the Organization received \$3,500,000 and \$5,000,000, respectively, from . The grant requires these payments to be held until environmental clearance is received, the construction start date is established, grant support totaling \$4,500,000 has been received in cash, and project financing and tax credits have been committed. As the Organization's management and Kresge consider the likelihood of not meeting all of these conditions to be remote, these amounts have been recorded as temporarily restricted contributions in the statements of activities during the years ended September 30, 2012 and 2011, respectively.

Two donors have committed contributions to the Organization in the amount of \$6,000,000 to be paid over six years. In exchange, these donors will have donor recognition for 10 years on assigned stations when the M-1 RAIL is completed. The amounts received from these two donors were \$-0- and \$1,000,000 during the years ended September 30, 2012 and 2011, respectively. Future contributions from these donors are contingent upon the Organization's obtaining sufficient funding to complete the project, as well as the progress of the construction.

NOTE A - NATURE OF OPERATIONS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Nature of Operations

M-1 RAIL (the "Organization") is a Michigan non-profit Corporation that includes Michigan foundations, businesses, and civic leaders primarily to acquire, own, operate, design, construct, and maintain a street railway, as enabled by legislation advanced by the State of Michigan. The railway, known as the M-1 RAIL, is a proposed 3.3-mile at-grade streetcar along the Woodward corridor from Larned to Grand Boulevard. The M-1 RAIL will be available to a larger, regional transportation system, connecting with many existing services, as well as with future rapid mass transit in southeast Michigan.

Tax-Exempt Status

The Organization is organized under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("IRC"), and has received a determination of its tax-exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") as a publicly supported organization under IRC section 509(a)(2). The Organization's management is not aware of any unrecognized tax benefits as of September 30, 2012 or 2011. The Organization is potentially subject to federal income tax examinations by the IRS for all years of the Organization's existence.

Basis of Presentation

The financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

The Organization reports information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

A capital program has been developed for the engineering, design and construction, and commissioning phases. Operation revenue and expense models have also been established, including subsidies, as permitted by the enabling legislation.

Fair Value Measurements

The Organization uses fair value measurements in the preparation of its financial statements, which utilize various inputs, including those that can be readily observable, corroborated, or are generally unobservable. The Organization utilizes market-based data and valuation techniques that maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. Additionally, the Organization applies assumptions that market participants would use in pricing an asset or liability, including assumptions about risk.

The measurement of fair value includes a hierarchy based on the quality of inputs used to measure fair value. Financial assets and liabilities are categorized into this three-level fair value hierarchy based on the inputs to the valuation technique. The fair value hierarchy gives the highest priority to quoted prices in active markets for identical assets and liabilities and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs.

The various levels of the fair value hierarchy are described as follows:

- Level 1 This category includes financial assets and liabilities whose values are based on unadjusted quoted market prices for identical assets and liabilities in an active market that the Organization has the ability to access.
- Level 2 This category includes financial assets and liabilities whose values are based on quoted prices in markets that are not active or model inputs that are observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.
- Level 3 This category includes financial assets and liabilities whose values are based on prices
 or valuation techniques that require inputs that are both unobservable and significant to the
 overall fair value measurement.

The use of observable market data, when available, is required in making fair value measurements. When inputs used to measure fair value fall within different levels of the hierarchy, the level within which the fair value measurement is categorized is based on the lowest level input that is significant to the fair value measurement.

As of September 30, 2012 and 2011, the Organization does not have any financial assets or liabilities subject to being classified in any of the aforementioned categories.

Contributions

Contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted support, depending on the existence and/or nature of any donor restrictions. Contributions of cash and other assets, including unconditional promises to give in the future, are reported as support when received or when conditions related to a contractual promise to give are substantially met, measured at estimated realizable value. All contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor. Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as an increase in unrestricted net assets if the restriction expires in the reporting period in which the contributions are recognized. All other donor-restricted contributions are reported as an increase in temporarily or permanently restricted net assets, depending on the nature of the restriction. When a temporary restriction expires (that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished), temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and are reported in the statements of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

Cash Equivalents

The Organization considers all highly liquid investments purchased with an original maturity of three months or less from the date of purchase, as well as all money market funds, to be cash equivalents.

Concentration of Credit Risk

Financial instruments which potentially subject the Organization to concentrations of credit risk consist principally of cash and cash equivalents.

Cash and cash equivalents are maintained at financial institutions and, at times, balances may exceed federally insured limits. All of the Organization's non-interest-bearing cash balances were fully insured as of September 30, 2012 due to a temporary federal program in effect from December 31, 2010 through December 31, 2012. Under the program, there is no limit to the amount of insurance for eligible accounts. Beginning in 2013, insurance coverage will revert to \$250,000 per depositor at each financial institution, and the Organization's non-interest-bearing cash balances may again exceed federally insured limits. Interest-bearing amounts on deposit in excess of federally insured limits as of September 30, 2012 approximated \$16,400,000.

Concentration of Credit Risk (continued)

During the year ended September 30, 2012, the Organization utilized three suppliers for purchases of \$1,149,380, or 65 percent of total purchases. Amounts totaling \$127,674 were due to these suppliers as of September 30, 2012.

Capital Project

Costs incurred for the development of the M-1 RAIL have been capitalized and are stated at their original cost if purchased or at their estimated value at the date of gift if donated. The Organization's policy is to depreciate the cost of the project on the straight-line basis over the estimated useful life of the asset of 40 years.

Furniture and Equipment

Furniture and equipment are stated at their original cost if purchased or at their estimated value at the date of gift if donated. Depreciation is computed on the straight-line basis over the estimated useful lives of the related assets, which range from four to ten years. The Organization capitalizes all expenditures for property and equipment in excess of \$500.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Subsequent Events

The Organization has evaluated subsequent events through June 27, 2013, the date that the accompanying financial statements were available to be issued.

NOTE E - DOWNTOWN DETROIT PARTNERSHIP

The Organization uses the services of Downtown Detroit Partnership ("DDP") for all management, accounting, and administrative services. DDP assigns certain of its employees to provide services for the Organization, which reimburses DDP for the pro-rata salaries and related employee benefits of those individuals. During the years ended September 30, 2012 and 2011, these costs totaled \$58,300 and \$53,750, respectively.

In addition, DDP serves as a fiscal agent to the Organization in administering the Transit Oriented Development project, funded by a \$2,100,000 grant from the Ford Foundation. Since DDP receives and disburses the funds, no revenue or expenses are recorded by the Organization.

NOTE F - SUBSEQUENT EVENT

In February 2013, the United States Secretary of the Treasury announced that a \$25 million transit grant will be used for the M-1 RAIL project. In April 2013, the Federal Transit Administration completed the environmental clearance process and has issued the Amended Record of Decision. This is the last step under the National Environmental Policy Act process and allows the M-1 RAIL project to progress to the next phases of design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction.
