IF THE DIRECTOR HAS A CONFIDENTIALITY OBLIGATION THAT PREVENTS HIM OR HER FROM DISCLOSING ANY MATERIAL FACTS, THEY MUST DISCLOSUE SUCH OBLIGATION.
- 3. THE DIRECTOR MAY ANSWER FACTUAL QUESTIONS FROM OTHER DIRECTORS AND STAFF AND MAY BRIEFLY STATE HIS OR HER POSITION ON THE MATTER.
- 4. THE DIRECTOR MUST RECUSE HIMSELF OR HERSELF FROM DELIBERATIONS ON THE MATTER.
- 5. THE DIRECTOR WILL ABSTAIN FROM VOTING ON THE MATTER AND WILL NOT BE PRESENT DURING VOTING.
