IN JANUARY 2009, THE PERSONNEL COMMITTEE HELD A JOINT CALL WITH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO FINALIZE A RECOMMENDATION FOR SALLY'S COMPENSATION. THIS RECOMMENDATION RESPONDED TO THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE HR DYNAMICS STUDY IN RELATION TO THE DATA ON CEO COMPENSATION AVAILABLE FROM CORPS. THE BOARD FOLLOWED AN EXTENSIVE AND DELIBERATE PROCESS TO DETERMINE A REASONABLE SALARY FOR THE CEO. THERE HAS BEEN NO SALARY INCREASE SINCE FEBRUARY 2009. DURING FY12, A SEARCH FOR A NEW CEO WAS IN PROCESS AND THE SEARCH COMMITTEE REFERRED TO THE EXPERTISE OF AN OUTSIDE SEARCH FIRM FOR CEO SALARY DETERMINATION.
