Expenses

a. Land Acquisition: The North Carolina Coastal Land Trust closed four separate conservation transactions, and assisted the State of NC with two others, protecting a total of more than 500 acres during the fiscal year.

\$624,415

Three of the four projects completed were undertaken in partnership with the US Marine Corps and the US Department of Defense. This "Military Encroachment Partnership" includes acquiring interests in land that have both conservation and military resources of public importance. At Everett Creek, we purchased 92 acres of forest adjacent to USMC Base Camp Lejeune, which had previously been permitted for development. To protect USMC Air Station Cherry Point, we purchased agricultural easements over 50 acres of farmland at Guthrie Farm, which adjoins Bogue Landing Field and we also acquired 46 acres of future parkland at Lewis Farm, near the Air Station's main base in Havelock. Our fourth project was a conservation easement donation at Bray Hollow near Greenville in Pitt County.

The two assists were additions to Pettigrew State Park in Washington County and Boiling Springs Lake Natural Area in Brunswick County.

Staff completed "pre-acquisition work," including grant-writing, appraisals and due diligence on a score of other projects, which will be closed in the future. Among the most significant developments for future acquisitions was the selection of the Coastal Land Trust by the US Attorney for the Eastern District of NC to receive a \$1M settlement from a pollution case; these funds, which will be received in installments beginning in 2013, will be dedicated to projects on the Waccamaw River.

b. Land Stewardship:	\$233,477
We monitored all of our properties during calendar year 2012. We resolved several stewardship issues. We marked boundary lines at one old preserve (Walker's Mill Pond). When faced with a gas pipeline condemnation, we negotiated re-location of the route to follow an existing power line corridor and a reduction in width of the right-of-way; in another case, we allowed the state Dept. of Transportation to condemn a wetland mitigation site rather than consent to an amendment to a conservation easement. We thinned timber as part of a longleaf restoration project at Everett Creek Preserve; removed stiltgrass (an exotic species) at Nevil's Creek Preserve; we carried out site preparation and planted longleaf seedlings at Brunswick Nature Park; and we designed, funded and carried out shoreline restoration and marsh grass planning at Springer's Point Preserve at Ocracoke Island. c. Conservation Planning. North Carolina Coastal Land Trust participated this year in the Cape Fear Arch Conservation Collaboration, and the Onslow Bight Initiative, in which various federal, state and Non-Governmental Organizations interested in protected conservation resources in the Onslow Bight area are pooling resources and personnel. We also participate in the Eastern Forest Coalition and the NC Land Trusts Council. This year we partnered with the City of Wilmington on the first phase of a plan to allow the City to enter into a long-term lease to manage a 40+acre site near an elementary school as a public nature park, which will be incorporated as part of the "Cross-City Trail". We also partnered with the City of Havelock to identify and negotiate acquisition of recreational tracts.	\$32,648

d. Conservation Education: We had great success with outreach this year. We expanded the "Flytrap Frolic" in the City of Wilmington to two days, with Friday set aside for school children and Saturday open to the public; more than 500 children benefitted. Our second annual "Family Fun Day at the new Brunswick Nature Park, was themed this year with more nature activities; we designed and distributed a guidebook, showcasing the plants, animals and trails; more than 750 kids, parents and friends attended. We hosted our first bike ride, in the countryside of Craven County; "Cyclists Goin' Coastal" was a success with almost 200 participants, which we hope to build upon in 2013. The Coastal Land Trust held an Annual Meeting of its members, a "Field Day at Five Eagles Farm" in Pender County, and a golf tournament in Wallace.
