Achievement for the fiscal year 2011-2012

#### **South Region:**

For this year, CEPVI hold twenty six (26) educational activities and impacted six hundred fifty seven (657) persons in community. Participated in forty eight (48) educational & health fairs and impacted one thousand six hundred twenty two (1,622) persons in diverse sectors of the south region of our geographic zone. We promote in the regional newspaper twenty (20) articles of the center & activities and promoted Independent Living Service (ILS) in four (4) radio station programs. Thirty nine (39) Awareness Campaign in the south region impacted one thousand forty six (1,046) persons, Twenty one (21) outreach activities impacted five hundred sixty four (564) person, Two hundred persons obtain an informative directory to available services in the south region, and fifteen (15) integration activities impacted four hundred twenty nine (429) persons. The number of people impacted in the community of twelve (12) municipalities in the south region was five thousand and nineteen (5,019)

CEPVI collaborate with 75 entities in the South Region. Three hundred sixty (360) persons received information and referral services, of these 220 persons (61%) received the services, 115 persons (32%) area in progress and 25 persons (7%) did not receive it for others reason such as: application decline, death, referring agency is not providing the service among others. 311 people established independent living goals in order to improve their quality of life and be more integrated in their community.

#### West Region:

In order to impact the greatest number of people with disabilities and ensure the independent living services to the western region, we coordinate with The Office of Independent Living and Independent Living Unit of Administration of Rehabilitation Vocational (ARV) the provision of this service, in accordance with the State Plan of Independent Living approved for the fiscal years 2011-2013 (SPIL). This plan identified the need for these services to people with disabilities living in towns where no has access to Independent Living services. The geographic region served consists of the following towns: Añasco, Aguada, Aguadilla, Isabela, Las Marias, Mayaguez, Moca, Rincón and San Sebastián.

The staff in charge of providing IL services is a Coordinator of Services an Independent Living Technician. Both employees (a) are entrusted with CEPVI Executive Director, to implement the three (3) Independent Living Core Services in each of the municipalities identified. The staffs perform different activities and / or efforts to achieve greater impact the number of people with independent living services. Results will be measured based on satisfaction survey of service and CSR records for each consumer which is done at the end of the fiscal year. For the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 the Compliance Work Plan was 85.37%.

### The most significant achievements were:

- D. The people in the community who benefited from the information and referral services were two hundred seventy-eight (278). Of these, 242 were able to get the service for an 88%, 22 are in process for 7% and 14 did not receive the service by other causes 5%.
- E. The personnel participated in sixty-two (62) community activities impacting 2,586 people. These are classified as follows:
  - Participation in thirty-eight (38) Health Fairs benefiting 1,995 people.
  - Participation in five (5) educational workshops impacting 183 people.

- F. Evaluation of services by consumers. Fifty-one (51) evaluated the services received. The statistics are broken down as follows:
- -The 76% received the service request and began receiving the service in a reasonable time.
- -The 78% indicates that he was informed about other services available.
- -The 100% indicates that they were treated with respect and kindness.
- -The 75% expressed that the service helped him be more independent.
- -The 86% expressed that they feel satisfied with the services.
- -The 94% recommended the service to others.

### G. Others

- 111 people established independent living goals in order to improve their quality of life and be more integrated in their community.
- Collaborative Agreement with the Municipality of Añasco, through the provision of office space and utilities.
- Collaborative agreements with fifteen (15) West Region agencies to publicize the services and establish a responsive referral system to the needs of people with disabilities by resident's area.
- Fifty (50) persons obtain an informative directory to available services in the western region.

• Acquisition of equipment VRI (Virtual Interpreter) to provide access to communication services for deaf person requesting the services.

# <u>CEPVI ensure equal access in a cross disabilities environment and we have implemented the following strategies:</u>

<u>Communication Access to the Visual Impaired</u>: We have the Duxbury program, JAWS Program and printer to translate into Braille language.

<u>Communication Access to the Hearing Impaired</u>: We provide this year collaborating with the Vocational Rehabilitation Administration, Sorenson's Communication, Sprint Relay and Hands of VRS to provide the access of both videophones and webcam to help promote the communication technology and help consumers achieved their access to technology and information goals including peer counseling. Other alternatives to bring services to deaf consumers in the centers are:

- <u>VRI-(Video Remote Interpreting)</u> It's a new technology for the deaf persons known virtual-interpretation". The staff of direct services was trained to operate the equipment by Mr. Beltran-Interpreter Coordinator of PR.
- <u>Sign Language Interpreters</u>-We guaranteed sign language interpreters every time it was needed.
- <u>Technological Equipment</u>: There are equipment's for the deaf people like: UltratecMiniprint 425, Dialogue VCO Phone, UltratecUniphone 1140, Ameriphone Dialogue XL-25 and D-Link DVC 1000 Videophone that are free of charge through the company's Sprint Relay. The delivery of these devices depend on the ease with which the SPRINT company's works.
