and corporation's mission; 3) Each scholarship awardee must commit to giving back to the organization by conducting a workshop
on what they learned, writing an article about their experience for the newsletter, or otherwise enriching the club by sharing what they

The scholarship awardee will be expected to pay a portion of the training on his or her own as our award will not cover the whole expense; 7) The scholarship will be awarded contingent on evidence of acceptance into a school or program or by a teacher. If circumstances change and the scholarship awardee is not able to participate in the training, the funds must be refunded to SFSF. The Scholarship Committee reviews each applicant based on the above criteria and makes a decision on scholarship award and amount. No scholarships were awarded in FY 2011.
