Chambers Family Fund was established to provide resources to regional and national nonprofit organizations that create systems change, improve the quality and circumstances of life and reflect the founder's values and interests. The Foundation increases access to opportunities that improve the chances for success and quality of life for those who are most impacted by economic and social injustice. Chambers Family Fund helps women become economically self-sufficient, promotes early care and education, strengthens justice, equality and opportunity, and supports the enduring contributions of Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art.

The Foundation makes a significant investment in direct charitable activities by investing time and expertise in special nonprofit initiatives. Through these activities and programs, Chambers Family Fund is proactively engaged in helping create new nonprofit organizations, participating in community planning, convening, supporting systems change, developing and expanding philanthropy and providing technical assistance for nonprofit effectiveness. The result is a more fully engaged approach that utilizes a combination of financial assistance, staff support, technical assistance and leadership.

The primary activities and programs are:

<u>Women's Funds Initiative</u> – In partnership with statewide community foundations, Chambers Family Fund created women's funds in Wyoming, Montana and Oklahoma, and provides ongoing support to these and to women's funds in North Dakota. The Foundation also provides technical assistance for women's funds to increase funding for women and girls and women's philanthropy in Colorado and throughout the country.

<u>Women's Economic Self-Sufficiency</u> – Ascend, a new initiative of the Aspen Institute, focuses on two-generation strategies that will lift single parents and children out of poverty. The Foundation partners in this national effort through service on the advisory board and by linking Colorado strategies and reforms to national efforts.

<u>Early Care and Education Reform</u> – The Foundation staff participate in collaborative efforts and community planning to create a statewide system of quality childcare in Colorado. Chambers Family Fund is a partner in a national initiative that links quality childcare to future educational success and serves in an advisory capacity to Tools of the Mind, a preschool and kindergarten curriculum that helps children reach their highest potential.

<u>Planning and Community Service</u> – The Foundation staff and board serve on task forces and planning committees that strategize and recommend solutions to issues in line with Chambers Family Fund's program areas: women's economic self-sufficiency, early care and education of children, justice, equality and opportunity and Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art.
