Martin's Point is proud to support our employees in their efforts and a blitty to make a difference in our communities. Thus, Martin's Point provides a volunteer time-off policy which makes it easier for our employees do adirect volunteer service and serve on community boards and committees. In 2012, our employees donated almost 2,000 h ours, which totals over \$54,000 paid in wages to employees for volunteer time. In addition, Martin's Point donated close to \$50,000 to charitable organizations and efforts in which our employees are engaged.
