

Line 1, Summary of Direct Charitable Activities

The Franklin Home for the Aged, aka the Peabody Home, exists for the sole purpose of operating a home for senior citizens from a single location in Franklin, NH. The Peabody Home, established in 1940, is a licensed intermediate care facility with 29 nursing beds,10 assisted living apartments and 4 independent living apartments. The Peabody Home is a private nursing home and has never participated in the Medicaid program. Residents pay for their nursing home services from their private funds. Daily room rates for the care are approximately 15% - 20% lower than rates from other NH facilities.
