Marion Gerrish Community Center Articles of Agreement and By-Laws

ARTICLE I

NAME

Section 1. The name of the organization shall be the "Marion Gerrish Community Center Inc." of Derry, Rockingham county, State of New Hampshire. Hereafter described as the MGCC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE AND POLICY MISSION STATEMENT

- Section 1. The purpose of the organization shall be to support new & existing programs for educational, recreational, civic, youth, elderly, service and non-profit organizations by providing and maintaining facilities for meetings as well as providing additional support for activities for the aforementioned. To inspire involvement by providing facilities and assistance to organizations that give back to the community.
- Section 2. The organization shall provide in full or part through various fund raising projects moneys to support the aforesaid programs.

By-Laws

ARTICLE I

MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 Composition

The membership of the MGCC shall be comprised of all persons who are interested in the MGCC and its activities and are willing to support its' programs. Membership eligibility shall include persons who reside in Derry and surrounding towns and are accepted by no less than two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall not exceed fifteen (15) be comprised of at least five (5) voting members and shall set a maximum number at their discretion.

Section 2. Term

Board members shall be elected to serve terms of three (3) years, after which they may be considered by the Nominating/Board Governance Committee for a second term. Future participation, after a hiatus of one (1) year, shall be at the discretion and invitation of the existing Board.

Section 3. Termination of Membership

Should a member of the Board of directors be absent without just cause, for a period of (3) months or for any other reason deemed sufficient by the Board of Directors, membership on the board may be terminated by a two thirds vote of those present and voting at any regular meeting of the Board.

ARTICLE II

OFFICERS

The officers of the organization shall be a President, Vice President, secretary and treasurer Treasurer. They, with the remaining members of the Board of Directors shall comprise the governing body of the organization

Section 1. Duties

A. The <u>President</u> shall preside at all meetings of the MGCC and shall be the ex-officio member of all committees. He/she shall have the usual power of supervision and management

- pertaining to that office. The President may in the absence of the Treasurer sign or endorse checks appoint committees as needed.
- B The <u>Vice-President</u> shall, in the absence of the President, possess all powers and perform the duties of the President. He/she shall be an ex-officio member of all committees and shall perform such other duties, as the President shall designate. In the event that the office of the President becomes vacant, the Vice-President shall assume the office of President until the next election.
- C. The <u>Secretary</u> shall keep the minutes of all regular meetings of the MGCC and of all the meetings of the Board of Directors. She/he will be responsible for meeting notification and the officer in charge of general correspondence.
- D. The <u>Treasurer</u> in conjunction with the Executive Director shall collect and receive all moneys due and shall be custodian of these moneys. They will keep accurate records of all financial transactions of the organization. They shall present monthly statements to the Board of Directors-and to the annual meetings They shall disburse no moneys without authorization from the Board of Directors in excess of \$500 \$1,000, other than contracted services The treasurer Treasurer shall be bonded.
- E. The Executive Board of Directors shall be comprised of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Executive Director. They shall be empowered to act in an emergency situation in the name of the Board of Directors. They may not reverse any action of the Board of Directors, and any action taken may be subject to ratification or approval at the next regular meeting of the Board of Directors. All Executive Board Members empowered to sign checks shall be bonded.

Section 2. Election of Officers

- A. The President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors in January—of the Board of Directors. They shall be selected from the Board of Directors. They shall be selected from a slate previously prepared by the Nominating Committee or from nominations from the floor
- B. In case there is but one nominee for each office, the secretary-Secretary may be instructed by unanimous vote to cast one ballot.
- C. The newly elected officers shall take office at the close of the meeting at which they are elected.
- D. The term of office will be for (1) one year-at a time.

ARTICLE III

COMMITTEES

Section 1. Appointment and Function

The President shall appoint the necessary officers of each committee. Each officer in consultation with the President selects his own committee members. The President and Vice President shall be ex-officio members of all committees.

Section 2. The committees shall be as necessity may dictate.

ARTICLE IV

MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular Meetings

Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held the second Wednesday of each month or as designated by the President no less frequently than quarterly, with the intent to meet monthly. The meeting shall be held at the MGCC at 7:30 a.m. unless otherwise noted. All members shall be notified in advance of special meetings. Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with "Robert's Rules of Order."

Section 2. Annual Meeting

An annual meeting shall be held in January of each year, the exact date to be determined by the Board of Directors. The annual meeting will:

- A. Nominate and elect officers for the following year
- B. Consider the MGCC long range plans for the following year.
- C. Present and discuss the yearly budget to the general membership.

Section 3. Quorum

A quorum of the Board of Directors shall consist of half plus one.

ARTICLE V

GENERAL FINANCES

Section 1 Operating Expenses

It is the intention that the MGCC may be self-supporting. The Organization may

- A. Raise moneys from room fees
- B Accept gifts and donations for both specific purposes or for the general fund
- C. Organize money-raising projects-through-a Ways and Means-Committee.
- D. Generate revenue from sales at the Marion Gerrish Thrift Shop.

Section 2. Petty Cash

A fund to be designated by the Board of Directors be available for incidental expenses. This fund shall be maintained by the Executive Director reporting to the Treasurer.

ARTICLE VI

AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

Section 1. The By-Laws

The by-laws of the MGCC are intended to be a flexible guideline necessary for the operation of an efficient organization.

Section 2. <u>Amendments of By-Laws</u>

The by-laws may be amended at any regular or annual meeting of the Board of Directors by a twothirds vote of the members present providing:

- The proposed amendment has been read at a previous meeting.
- B. Written nNotice has been sent to each member of the board of Directors by the Secretary at least (7) seven days prior to the meeting.

ARTICLE VII

DIVESTMENT OF PROPERTY

Section 1. Should the Marion Gerrish Community Center, Inc. become inactive or by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors cease to exist, the Board of Directors, as governing body of the organization, may dispose of, to such other charitable or non-profit organization of similar purpose, qualifying under IRS Code, Sec. 501 C 3 all or in part of any real property, cash on hand and (or) invested funds held by the aforementioned Corporation, as may be stipulated by unanimous vote of the Board of Directors.

Should no disposition of property be made after a period of five (5) years of total inactivity by the aforementioned corporation, all real property, cash on hand and invested funds shall be vested to the Town of Derry, Rockingham County, State of New Hampshire, for disposition as may be deemed proper.
