#### 2) Casa Comunitaria Brito-Barrancas and Rural Education: \$14,277

This community center is the base of our rural programs, and houses a small educational computer center, a small primary and high school library, and facilities for cultural and workshop classes in a range of areas, periodically including dance and carpentry. This program includes a scholarship program that has grown to over 45 rural high school and 15 community college students, offers subsidized school supplies to low-income rural families, assists a remote primary through high school of 100+ students with seven teachers, assists the rural kindergarten that we founded in 2001, and runs a small educational urban computer center with Internet, for low income urban and rural students

#### 3) Rural Assistance and Development, Sustainable Eco-Agriculture: \$5,890

This hands-on directed assistance applies to approximately 80 families, benefiting more then 400 family members in all, with a small model farm offering community participation in sustainable land use and ecoagriculture, alternative (solar) energy and water resource projects, housing and infrastructure assistance, family emergencies and micro enterprise.

#### 4) Reproductive Health Educational Workshops: \$4,389

Education and information on sexual and reproductive health, family planning, sexually transmitted infections and diseases, gender-based perspectives, etc., in schools and public health facilities in several counties, to adolescents and young adults both within and outside of the school system.
