


NOTE 1 – ORGANIZATION

Shriners International Pyramid Temple-Milford, CT is a subordinate temple of the Shriners International. The Temple remits certain fees and charges to the imperial Council for granting dispensations, charters, certificates and diplomas and for Shriners Hospitals for Children and other charitable purposes. Such fees, charges and hospital levy paid to The Shriners International were \$8,100 and \$10350 for 2012 and 2011 respectively. The Temple also sponsors various units and clubs. Certain units and clubs maintain funds outside the control of the Temple governing body.

Pyramid Asset Management Corp. was organized as a C corporation in May 1984.

NOTE 2 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Business Purpose – The activities of the Temple are supported principally through dues from members and fund-raising activities. Additionally, fund raising activities, generally consisting of paper sale crusade, bingo and other miscellaneous activities, are held for the benefit of the Shriners Hospitals for Children. In the case of activities held for the benefit of the Shriners Hospitals, activities can only be sponsored with the written approval of The Shriners International and of The Shriners Hospital for Children. All of the net proceeds for such activities are remitted to the Shriners Hospitals for Children or, with written permission; a portion may be retained by the Temple's Shrine Hospital Patient Transportation Fund.

Pyramid Asset Management Corp. was organized as a C corporation in May 1984 for the purpose of holding and managing assets of the Temple.

Basis of presentation - The financial statements of the Shriners International Pyramid Temple- Milford, CT have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting. The significant accounting polices followed are described below to enhance the usefulness of the financial statements to the reader.

NOTE 2 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

The accompanying statements have been prepared on the accrual basis if accounting. All financial transactions have been recorded and reported as either unrestricted or temporarily restricted or permanently restricted net assets based on the existence or absence of donor imposed restrictions.

Unrestricted net assets consist of investments and otherwise unrestricted amounts that are available for use in carryout the activities of the Temple.

Temporarily restricted net assets consist of contributions received for the Shrine Hospital Patient Transportation Fund, life membership dues and plant additions or improvements, if applicable. Net assets released from restrictions represents expenses incurred during the year that satisfied the restricted purpose.

Permanently restricted net assets consist of contributions that are subject to donor imposed stipulations that they be maintained by the Temple. Generally, the donors of these assets permit the Temple to use all or part of the income earned on related investments for general or specific purposes.

Cash and Cash Equivalents – For purposes of the statement of cash flows, the Temple considers all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with a maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents. As of December 31, 2012 and 2011, total cash and cash equivalents of \$39,801 and \$40,606 respectively, consisted of the following:

NOTE 2 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Dues and Assessments – dues and hospital assessments are accrued for all members at the beginning of the fiscal year, but are recorded at the end of the year for members demitted and for members suspended for nonpayment of dues.

Inventories – inventories are stated at lower of cost on a first-in, first out method or market.

Investments – investments in stocks and bonds are carried at lower of cost or market.

Furniture, Fixtures and Leasehold Improvements – Furniture, fixtures and leasehold improvements are stated at cost. Maintenance and repairs are charged to operations as incurred. At the time items are retired or disposed of, the applicable cost and accumulated depreciation are cleared from the accounts and the difference, net of proceeds, is charged or credited to operations.

Income Taxes – Shriners International has obtained exemption from income taxes under Section 501© (10) of the Internal Revenue Code. This exemption includes all subordinate Shrine temples. However, certain other revenues such as advertising may be subject to taxation.

Use of Estimates – Management of the temple has made a number of estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures in these financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Contributed Services – no amounts have been reflected in the financial statements for donated services. The Temple pays for most services requiring specific expertise. However, many individuals (Shriners and non-Shriners) volunteer their time in performing a variety of tasks that assist the Temple operations and support to Shriners Hospital for Children.

Asset and Liability Liquidity – On the Statement of Financial Position, the assets have been presented in a sequence according to their nearness of conversion to cash and the liabilities have been sequenced according to their nearness of their maturity and resulting use of cash.

Life Membership – Money received from Nobles purchasing life memberships shall be placed in a perpetual fund. Only income from the fund may be withdrawn and used for the operating expenses of the temple, unless temple bylaws provide for the release of dues upon the death of the life member.

Principle of Combination – The combined financial statements included the accounts of the Shriners International Pyramid Temple – Milford, CT and the Pyramid Asset Management Corp. which are related through common control. The Pyramid Asset Management Corp. was created so that substantially all of its activities are conducted on behalf of the Temple. All intercompany accounts and transactions have been eliminated in combination.

NOTE 3 – ADOPTION OF ACCOUNTING PRONOUNCEMENT

FASB Accounting Standards Codification became effective for interim and annual periods after September 15, 2009. The prior provisions of the Statement of Financial Accounting Standards (SFAS) to be adopted were effective January 1, 1996 for accounting standard number 116, 117 and 124.

NOTE 4 – FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

The activities of the Temple and its affiliated entities are supported principally through dues from members and fundraising activities consisting of Comedy Night, Sunday Breakfast and other miscellaneous activities. Additionally, fundraising events consisting of paper crusades donations, football games, golf tournaments and other miscellaneous events, are also held for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals for Children. In the case of activities held for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals, events can only be sponsored with the written approval of Shriners International and of the Shriners Hospitals for Children. All of the net proceeds from such activities are remitted to the Shriners Hospitals for Children or, with written permission; a portion may be retained by the Temple's Shrine Hospital Patient Transportation Fund.

NOTE 5 – FIXED ASSETS

Fixed assets are stated at cost. The following is a summary of the fixed assets included in the Plant Fund with respective accumulated depreciation as of December 31, 2012.

The total depreciation expense for the year ended December 31, 2010 was \$28,915.

NOTE 6 – FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS WITH OFF BALANCE SHEET RISK

The Temple maintains several bank accounts at one bank. Accounts in the banks were guaranteed by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) up to \$250,000 in 2012 and 2011. Cash did not exceed federally insured limits as of December 31, 2012 and 2011.

The Pyramid Asset Management Corp. sold their building and land located in Milford, CT in 2010. The net proceeds from the sale of this property remain in the Pyramid Asset Management Corp. at December 31, 2012. The total cash and cash equivalents at December 31, 2010 was \$ 875,106. Management diversified its cash position at December 31, 2012 with six different bank and brokerage firms each intentionally limited to the \$250,000 FDIC limit. Therefore, with respect to PAM Corp's cash it did not exceed federally insured limits at December 31, 2012. The total cash and cash equivalents at December 31, 2011 was \$68,907.

NOTE 7- RECLASSIFICATIONS Certain reclassifications have been made to the prior period financial statements to be consistent with current year presentation. These reclassifications had no effect on net income or retained earnings.
