The Gladys Brooks Foundation was created under the 516-746-6103 Will of the late Gladys Brooks Thayer of New York. Its purpose is to provide for the intellectual, moral and physical welfare of the people of this country by establishing and supporting non-profit libraries, educational institutions, hospitals and clinics.

GENERAL POLICIES

As a matter of policy, the Foundation will make grants only to publicly supported not-for-profit tax-exempt organizations within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code.

Grant applications will be considered where {a} outside funding (including governmental) is not available; {b} the project will be largely funded by the grant unless the grant request covers a discrete component of a larger project and {c} the funds will be used for capital projects including equipment or endowments. Applications for direct salary support will not be accepted.

Generally the Board will only entertain grant applications from applicants located in the states of: Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee and Vermont.

Grant applications will be considered only for major expenditures generally between \$50,000.00 and \$100,000.00 and greater or lesser amounts in certain circumstances.

All grant awards are made on the condition that the entirety of the funds advanced shall be utilized in direct furtherance of the project and that no portion thereof shall be appropriated by the Grantee as an administrative or processing fee, for overseeing the project or for its general overhead.

The Board follows the practice of determining at the beginning of each calendar year a limited scope of activities for which it will consider grant applications for that year. Any significant change in the objectives of the Foundation will be posted on its website.

If the applicant receives a Second Round Grant Questionnaire the Foundation is seriously considering applicant's application and will require that the following documents be provided: budget for the year 2013 when available; Internal Revenue Service exemption letter; latest Internal Revenue Service information return; an opinion of counsel with respect to applicant's tax exemption and applicant's legal authority to accept the grant.

This information is <u>not</u> required to be submitted until and if applicant receives a Second Round Grant Questionnaire. Receiving a Second Round Grant Questionnaire does not guarantee approval and funding of the application.

SCOPE OF GRANTS THAT WILL BE CONSIDERED IN 2012

For 2012, the Foundation will consider grant applications in the fields of libraries, education, hospitals and clinics.

LIBRARIES

Grant applications will be considered generally for resource endowments (print, film, electronic database, speakers/workshops) capital construction and innovative equipment. Projects fostering broader public access to global information sources utilizing collaborative efforts, pioneering technologies and equipment are encouraged.

EDUCATION

Grant applications from universities, colleges and secondary schools will be considered generally for {a} educational endowments to fund scholarships based solely on educational achievements, leadership and academic ability of the student; {b} endowments to support fellowships and teaching chairs for educators who confine their activities primarily to classroom instruction in the liberal arts, mathematics and the sciences during the academic year and {c} erection or endowments of buildings, wings or additions thereof of buildings and equipment for educational purposes.

HOSPITALS AND CLINICS

Grant applications from hospitals and clinics will be considered generally where the proposal demonstrates one or more of the following: {a} a new health need; {b} an improvement in the quality of health care or {c} reduced health costs with better patient outcomes. Generally, no grant will be considered that is to support a laboratory research project. Proposals for a continuing project must include a commitment from the applicant or a third party that the project will continue to receive all the necessary financial support after the grant from the Foundation is expended.

APPLICATION

The application must be completed and postmarked with all supporting documents to the Foundation within <u>45 days</u> from the date of the letter or memorandum from the Foundation furnishing the application to the applicant unless the Foundation letter or memorandum is dated after April 18, 2012 in which case the application must be postmarked with all supporting documents on or before June 1, 2012. The Foundation does encourage early filing of the application.

Electronic submission of the application and supporting documents is not acceptable.
