1.) a misinte	rpretation of "unusual grants" as defined by Schedule A instructions. In previous returns, some gifts were treated as unusual
grants due i	merely to the amount of the gift. Further research proved that these gifts were not large enough to endanger the organization's
public supp	ort status and were also not unusual nor unexpected in nature. This misinterpretation lead to an understatement of contributions.
2.) a failure	to adjust the schedule from cash-basis (effective through the end of 2009) to accrual-basis (beginning in 2010).
3.) a misinte	erpretation of "disqualified person" as defined in Appendix A of the IRS 990 Instructions. In previous returns, some gifts were
treated as ir	ndividual donor gifts and where then coded as from disqualified persons. Further research proved that these gifts were disbursed
from a <u>501(</u> 0	c)(3) publicly supported, community foundation maintaining donor-advised funds. They should, therefore, not have been reported
as gifts fron	n individuals, let alone as gifts from disqualified persons. This misinterpretation lead to an overstatement of amounts
received fro	om disqualified persons.
4.) in establ	ishing the 2% threshold for determining if a person qualifies as a substantial contributor, only individual gifts greater than \$5,000

Limiting the	total contribution figure to those only over \$5,000 reduces the threshold figure thereby increasing the amount of persons

Starting in 2	012, we revamped our fund raising processes to ensure more accurate and consistent accounting of contributions and we
eliminated e	external preparation of our tax returns, both in an effort to ensure accuracy and transparency with all contributions.


