El Salvador is a program where we train on ENT doctor in ear surgery and as well perform surgery of the ISSH hospital, due to the shortage of skilled doctors to do the surgery. Bolivia is a humanitarian program were we assist the community of Trinidad and as well train the local ENT in ear surgery. Paraguay is a developing program with a local NGO and the University, and in the next 18 months it should be moving along. All GEO programs are designed to educate and create sustainable programs with the doctors in the communities we work in.
