LEGAL PRINCIPLES

Three Duties of the Board of Directors

- prudent person in a like position would exercise; making Duty of Care—acting in good faith to make reasonable judgments and decisions with the care an ordinary or reasonable judgments.
- interest of the organization; avoiding conflicts of interests Duty of Loyalty— always doing what is in the best between organizational and personal interests.

By-Laws

- the "Rule Book" that outlines how the organization will operate

Non-profit -501(c)(3) tax-exempt status

- the status given by the IRS to organizations that have a charitable purpose & are exempt from federal income taxes
