CASR is registered as a non-profit organization by the country of Rwanda a difficult challenge. This CASR document is posted on line.
CASR is operated by its own independent board and is considered our sister organization. We are in daily email contact with CASR.
CASR sends to CASA two detailed monthly financial statements. One concerns monthly expenses to operate the current rented facility. The
budget for this house is \$2800 per month. The second statement concerns the expense of construction. This statement details how
construction money is spent. Either the director or the president of CASA visits the constuction site twice a year to carry out an onsite
evaluation of construction and to inspect financial record-keeping. This building has its own website at "lighthouse-huye.com". Pictures of
construction progress are posted at the site.
CASA typically wires money from our Wells Fargo CASA account to CASR's Ecobank account in Kigali. We maintain records of all these wire
transactions We also maintain copies of all check donations and have printouts of bank statements back to 2006.
We also maintain thousands of photo and video documentations of our missionary activity and construction efforts.
