The reporting foundation has agreed with the GRAT to comply with the expenditure responsibility rules as required by IRC Section 4945 and has entered into grant agreements with the GRAT (the "Grant Agreement"). As a grantee foundation the reporting foundation has agreed to use the grants for the purpose outlined in the Grant Agreement.

The reporting foundation further acknowledges that the required distributions of the GRAT, as defined by IRC section 4942(g)(3),totals \$31,477,028 in the case of the Stock GRAT, and pursuant to the Grant Agreement, the reporting foundation will undertake such distributions on or prior to December 31, 2013.
