Baal Dan Charities focuses on identifying trustworthy organizations and partnerships in India that are child focused and provide essential aid, shelter and education to vulnerable children including orphans and street children. Over the course of 2012, Baal Dan audited these organizations and defined grant agreements that would help children at these projects with feeding programs, supplies and education support. Over 150 project partners have been audited by Baal Dan since its inception and through our vetting process only 14 projects were selected in 2012 for grants. These projects were then held to reporting the impact of their grant and Baal Dan provides its donors with photos and video reports of the impact of its grant distributions throughout the year.

The charity's accomplishments since its inception include providing aid to over 3,000 children. In 2012 the charity provided 200 education sponsorships (including school fees, uniforms and supplies), supporting a school for 150 children, providing complete operational support for 2 orphanages housing 32 children and providing significant grants for biosanitation systems, orphanage supplies and building, feeding programs and medical care impacting 1,500 children.

Baal Dan raises money in the United States and then provides grants to projects in India. Grants are allocated to orphanages, school,

charities and grassroot projects in India that have been audited (personally visited) by a Baal Dan representative and meet certain

requirements. Baal Dan works with these projects to determine how best to help the children in their care.

In order for a project to receive a grant money certain requirements must be met. A grant application is required annually for each project.

This application requires, among other things, a statement of the projects purpose and goals along with a brief description of sources of

funds. The grant requestor agrees to use the funds provided by Baal Dan directly for the children it serves. It also agrees to provide written

reports to Baal Dan as to the use of the funds as well as maintain records and receipts for Baal Dan's review upon request. The projects

selected for grants must allow unrestricted access to Baal Dan's representatives for purposes of project review, either through personal

site visits, phone discussions or emails. Also, each grant requestor must certify that it has not provided and will not provide support or

resources to any individual or organization that advocates, plans, sponsors, engages in, or has engaged in terrorist activity.

Once grant requests have been received, each request is reviewed and determined whether the project is stable, reputable and in keeping

with Baal Dan's purpose and goals. All grants over \$5,000 are approved by Baal Dan's board of directors. In most cases funds are wired to

the grant recipient.
