Beginning in 2010 World's Children contracted the services of a nonprofit in India called the Spandana Society to help us monitor, evaluate and communicate more effectively with the orphanages and hostels we support in India.

The 48 orphanages assisted by World's Children help WC publicize the availability of the scholarships. Another significant contributor to the scholarship process is a Nursing School, the E.T.C.M. Hospital School of Nursing in Kolar, India. This school offers recipients of scholarships through WC an additional discount of 50% off of their tuition. If a student has remaining fees, they can work off the fees at the E.T.C.M. hospital upon graduation.
