#### CARING NEIGHBOR FOUNDATION ACTIVITIES

Over the past several years the Caring Neighbor Foundation (CNF) has made many grants ranging from \$300-\$1,200 to various Michigan human services endeavors. Grantees and the typical yearly services provided by the grantee include the following:

2.1.1. Program (Program with the United Way of Lansing) provides assistance to individuals and families who call 211 due to need of shelter, food, medicine, clothing or for some other welfare crisis.

Loaves and Fishes of Lansing shelters 275 (200 children) and provides 6,000 meals.

SIREN of Charlotte shelters 475 including 230 children and provides 19,000 meals.

GLEAP of Grand Ledge provides assistance for food, shelter or medicine for 1200 adults and 900 children

Haven House of E. Lansing shelters 350 adults and 200 children.

Heart and Hands of Eaton Rapids provides food for 111,450 meals to 2088 adults and 1627 children.

Resolution Restorative Justice Center (Program within the Restorative Justice Agency) works largely in Michigan schools to resolve antagonisms resulting from bulling, misunderstandings or ongoing conflicts among students.

**Tri-County Alcohol Awareness Committee (TCAAC),** on behalf of TCAAC, the CNF sponsored a student essay/poem contest centered on the theme 'Stay Cool, Stay Sober'. The aim of the contest was to raise awareness among students attending about the dangers of drugs/alcohol.

The CNF is the cooperative effort of caring neighbors to alleviate the suffering of fellow neighbors who are experiencing hard times. Caring is the fertile soil from which our Nation grows and prospers. No one directly involved in the CNF receives any compensation other than what comes from caring for one another and for neighbors who are hurting. An annual Michigan Caring Neighbor Day on the last Sunday of September each year will remind the people of Michigan that caring about each other is the true bedrock for building the new Michigan. Michigan once led the world in industry; Michigan can once more lead the world this time through caring and thereby unleash the creative forces within each citizen that will rebuild our State
