Additional Services such as vaccines, testing, de-wormer and flea and tick treatment are offered only at the time of surgery. We do not offer "wellness" services for any non-surgical patients.

The Oklahoma City Animal Welfare Division (Oklahoma City Animal Shelter) admitted over 26,700 dogs and cats into the shelter in 2011. Approximately 18,500 of those animals were dogs and puppies. Of the dogs and puppies admitted, 30.5% of them were surrendered by their owners. Owner-surrender animals do not need to stay in the shelter for a stray time but frequently become exposed to life-threatening illnesses upon entering the general population at a traditional shelter. OK Humane constructed the Homeward Bound Transport Facility right next door to the Oklahoma City Animal Shelter so the OK Humane team can directly transfer owner-surrender dogs and puppies from the shelter into the quarantine facility.
