NATURE OF OPERATIONS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. Nature of Operations

The United Way of Bradford County (the "Organization") is an affiliated member of the United Way of America. The Organization solicits contributions from local employers and individuals for the purpose of supporting operating expenses of selected not-for-profit agencies located throughout Bradford County, Pennsylvania.

2. Accounting Basis

The financial records of the Organization are maintained on an accrual basis of accounting.

3. Income Tax Status

The Organization is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

4. Unfulfilled Pledges

As of the Balance Sheet date, there were unfulfilled pledges that are not recorded in the financial statements. The Organization reports and budgets allocations based on cash received. There is a high uncertaintly that the pledges will be realized in the following year. As of the report date, no material pledges receivable had been collected.

5. **Donated Services**

A substantial number of volunteers have donated time to the Organization's program services during the year; however, these donated services are not reflected in the financial statements since the services do not require specialized skills.

6. Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosures of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statement and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

The United Way of Bradford County incurred \$5,400 of advertising expenses for the year ended December 31, 2012.

10. Fixed Assets / Depreciation

Fixed Assets are comprised of office equipment. Depreciation is calculated using the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets which is estimated to be 5 years. Depreciation for the year ended December 31, 2012 amounted to \$200.

11. Contributions

All contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor.

12. Deposits With Banks

The organization maintains its cash in a local financial institution which at times may exceed federally insured deposit amounts.

13. Marketable Securities

The organization was fortunate to receive a substantial unrestricted bequest in 2012. The board of directors has presently decided to invest the amount with the trust department of a local financial institution. The balance of the investments in the account amounted to \$385,119 at December 31, 2012.

The organization also owns through a contribution shares of stock having a market value of \$537 at December 31, 2012
