AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS

<u>OF</u>

THE RODMAN FOUNDATION

ARTICLE I

Offices

- Section 1. <u>Registered Office</u>. The registered office of The Rodman Foundation (the "Corporation") in the State of Minnesota shall be as stated in the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation (the "Articles"), or such other place within the State as the Board of Directors may designate from time to time.
- Section 2. <u>Principal Office</u>. The principal office of the Corporation shall be at 30 East 7th Street, Suite 2000, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101, or at such other place as the Board of Directors shall designate from time to time. The business of the Corporation shall be transacted from the principal office, and the records of the Corporation shall be kept there.
- Section 3. Other Offices. The Corporation may have such other offices within and without the State of Minnesota as the Board of Directors may determine.

ARTICLE II

<u>Members</u>

This Corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE III

Board of Directors

- Section 1. General Powers. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of a Board of Directors. In addition to the powers conferred upon the Board of Directors by these Bylaws, the Board of Directors may exercise all powers of the Corporation and perform all acts which are not prohibited to it by law, by the Articles or by these Bylaws, all as may be amended.
- Section 2. <u>Number</u>. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be composed of not less than three (3) nor more than fifteen (15) members, as determined from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Corporation. No decrease in the number of Directors pursuant to this Section shall effect the removal of any Director then in office.

- Section 3. <u>Qualifications</u>. Directors may only be natural persons and a majority of Directors must be adults. Each Director shall demonstrate his or her willingness to accept responsibility for governance and his or her availability to participate actively in governance activities. Directors shall be selected to bring a variety of interests and expertise to the Corporation.
- Section 4. Term of Office and Election. The Board of Directors shall be divided into four (4) groups of Directors, based on the length of the term to be served by such Directors, so that the terms of office of approximately one-fourth of the Directors shall expire each year. Each Group shall correspond with one of the four (4) family branches of the Rodman Foundation, and each Group shall contain only Director(s) who are members of the Group's corresponding family branch. In determining the time served by a Director, the period ending at the first annual meeting of the Directors shall be deemed to be one (1) year. The initial term of Group I Directors shall expire at the annual meeting of Directors held in 2013; the initial term of Group II Directors shall expire at the annual meeting of Directors held in 2014; the initial term of Group III Directors shall expire at the annual meeting of Directors held in 2015; and the initial term of Group IV Directors shall expire at the annual meeting of Directors held in 2016. Following expiration of the initial term of each group, the successor Directors of each group shall thereafter be elected by the Board of Directors for a term of four (4) years. A Director's term shall expire at the annual meeting of Directors at which the Director's group must stand for reelection. Each Director shall serve until the expiration of his or her term of office, and thereafter until a successor has been elected and qualified, or until the earlier death, resignation, removal or disqualification of the Director.
- Section 5. <u>Vacancy</u>. If the office of any elected Director becomes vacant for any reason, the Board of Directors may choose a successor from among the members of the family branch associated with that Director Group, by the election of a Director by the remaining Directors of the Corporation, or the Board of Directors may leave such position vacant so long as the number of Directors does not fall below the minimum number of Directors set forth in Section 2 of this Article III. A Director elected to fill a vacancy shall hold office until the next election of members of the Group of Directors which contains the vacancy.
- Section 6. <u>Removal of Directors</u>. A Director of the Corporation may be removed, at any time, with or without cause, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of all Directors of the Corporation then in office, excluding the Director proposed for removal.
- Section 7. <u>Resignation</u>. Any Director may resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to the Secretary of the Corporation. Such resignation shall be effective upon delivery, unless a later date is specified in the notice.
- Section 8. <u>Compensation</u>. Directors may receive compensation from the Corporation for services as a Director. In addition, Directors shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for services rendered to the Corporation in any other capacity. All compensation of Directors shall be in exchange for the performance of personal services that are reasonable and necessary to carry out the exempt purposes of the Corporation. The amount of such compensation shall not exceed what is reasonable under all of the circumstances, and shall not exceed the amount that

would ordinarily be paid for similar services by similar organizations under similar circumstances. The Corporation shall be entitled to purchase officers' and Directors' liability insurance without obtaining reimbursement of all or any part of the premium without violating these Bylaws.

Section 9. <u>Confidentiality</u>. From time to time, confidentiality at meetings of the Board of Directors of the Corporation may be vital to promoting free and candid discussions, deliberations, records and other information generated in connection with the activities of the Board. The President or the Corporation's legal counsel may designate certain agenda items or topics as confidential. Members of the Board of Directors shall make no disclosure with regard to these confidential items or topics except as authorized by the President or by the Corporation's legal counsel. For all other agenda items or topics, Directors shall exercise prudent judgment with regard to whether the information should be disclosed to others.

ARTICLE IV

Meetings of the Board of Directors

- Section 1. Place and Time of Meetings. The Board of Directors may hold its annual, regular and special meetings at such places, within or without this state, as determined by the President of the Corporation or his or her designee unless the Board of Directors determines otherwise. The Board of Directors may determine that one or more meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held solely by means of remote communication pursuant to Section 9 below. Such authorization may be general or confined to specific instances.
- Section 2. <u>Annual Meetings</u>. The Board of Directors shall hold an annual meeting. At each annual meeting, the Board of Directors shall elect members of the Board of Directors in such numbers as required or permitted by the Articles and these Bylaws, shall elect officers and shall conduct such other business as may properly come before it.
- Section 3. Regular Meetings. In addition to the annual meeting, the Board of Directors shall hold regular meetings as the President, or his or her designee, shall determine. At each regular meeting, the Board of Directors shall conduct such business as may properly come before the meeting.
- Section 4. Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by: (a) the President, or (b) upon written request of any two (2) or more Directors of the Corporation. A person entitled to call a special meeting of the Board of Directors may make a written request to the Secretary to call the meeting. The Secretary shall give written notice of the meeting in the manner provided below, and the meeting shall be held between three (3) and fourteen (14) days after receipt of the request to call a special meeting. If the Secretary fails to give notice of the meeting within three (3) days from the day on which the request was received by the Secretary, the person or persons who requested the special meeting may fix the time and place of meeting, and give notice thereof.
- Section 5. Notice of Meeting. Not less than ten (10) days' written notice of the annual meeting of the Board of Directors, excluding the day of the meeting, shall be given to all

Directors. Said notice shall include proposed agenda items, but the failure to include an agenda item in the notice shall not prevent action from being taken with respect to such item.

Not less than five (5) days' written notice of a regular meeting and three (3) days' written notice of a special meeting of the Board of Directors, excluding the day of the meeting, shall be given to all Directors. No notice of any meeting, regular or special, need state the purpose of the meeting except as may be specifically required by these Bylaws or otherwise required by law. Notice of a meeting at which an amendment to the Articles of the Corporation will be proposed must contain the substance of the proposed amendment.

Notice shall be delivered personally, sent by facsimile communication, sent by electronic mail, posted on an electronic network together with a separate notice to the Director of the specific posting, mailed, first class, postage prepaid, or such other methods as are fair and reasonable as determined in the sole discretion of the Secretary of the Corporation. Whenever written notice to Directors provides less than five (5) days' prior written notice of the meeting, excluding the date of the meeting, reasonable effort shall be made to notify Directors by telephone of the meeting at the time of giving written notice, but the failure to contact any Director(s) by telephone shall not affect the validity of the meeting or any action taken at such meeting.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, no written notice of any meeting of the Board of Directors is required if the date, time and place of the meeting was announced at a previous meeting of the Board. Any Director may waive notice of any meeting of the Board of Directors in writing before, at or after a meeting. The attendance of a Director at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, unless he or she objects at the beginning of the meeting to the transaction of business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened and does not participate in the meeting. The waiver shall be filed with the person who has been designated to act as secretary of the meeting, who shall enter the waiver upon the records of the meeting.

Section 6. Quorum and Voting. The presence of a majority of the members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board of Directors, but the Directors present at any meeting, although less than a quorum, may adjourn the meeting from time to time. If a quorum is present when a duly called or held meeting is convened, the Directors present may continue to transact business until adjournment, even though the withdrawal of Directors originally present leaves less than the proportion or number otherwise required for a quorum. Participation in a meeting by remote communication pursuant to Section 9 below constitutes presence at a meeting. At any meeting of the Board of Directors, except as otherwise provided in the Articles or these Bylaws, each Director present at the meeting shall be entitled to cast one (1) vote on any question coming before the meeting. Except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, a majority vote of the Directors present at any meeting, shall be sufficient to transact any business.

Proxy voting shall not be permitted.

Section 7. <u>Rules of Procedure</u>. The Board of Directors may adopt or establish rules of procedure for conducting meetings provided such rules are not inconsistent with the Articles, these Bylaws or Minnesota law. In the absence of Board action the President may establish rules of procedure for conducting meetings provided such rules are not inconsistent with the Articles, these Bylaws or Minnesota law.

Section 8. Action without Meeting. An action required or permitted to be taken at a Board Meeting may be taken by written action signed by the number of Directors that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which all Directors were present. If any written action is taken by less than all of the Directors entitled to vote, all Directors entitled to vote shall be notified immediately of its text and effective date. The failure to provide such notice, however, shall not invalidate such written action. A Director who has not signed or consented to the written action has no liability for the action or actions taken thereby. A written action is effective when it is signed by all of the Directors required to take the action unless a different effective time is provided in the written action. For purposes of this Section, an electronic signature satisfies the requirement of a signature so long as the electronic communication containing the electronic signature sets forth sufficient information from which the Corporation can reasonably conclude that the communication was actually sent by the purported sender.

Section 9. Remote Communications for Board Meetings. One or more Directors may participate in a meeting of the Board of Directors by means of a conference telephone or, if authorized by the Board of Directors, by another means of remote communication, in each case through which that Director, other Directors so participating, and all Directors present at the meeting may participate with each other during the meeting. Alternatively, if authorized by the Board of Directors, any meeting among Directors may be conducted solely by one or more means of remote communication through which all of the Directors may participate in the meeting. For these purposes, "remote communication" means communication via electronic communication, conference telephone, video conference, the Internet, or such other means by which persons not physically present in the same location may communicate with each other on a substantially simultaneous basis.

ARTICLE V

Officers

Section 1. <u>Number</u>. The Corporation shall have the following officers: (a) President; (b) a Vice President; (c) a Secretary; and (d) a Treasurer. Officers must be natural persons that the Board of Directors elects or appoints. Subject to these Bylaws, the Board of Directors may also elect or appoint one or more additional officers or assistant officers it may deem convenient or necessary. Except as provided in these Bylaws, the Board of Directors shall fix the powers and duties of all officers.

Section 2. <u>Election and Term of Office</u>. All officers of the Corporation shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors. Officers of the Corporation shall hold office at the discretion of the Board of Directors and shall be Directors of the Corporation. An officer shall hold office

until his or her successor shall have been elected or until his or her prior death, resignation or removal from office as hereinafter provided. An individual may hold more than one office of the Corporation at the same time except for the office of President.

Section 3. Removal and Vacancies. Any officer appointed by the Board of Directors shall hold office at the pleasure of the Board of Directors and may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by a resolution approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Directors present. Any vacancy in an office of the Corporation shall be filled by action of the Board of Directors. The removal of any individual as an officer of the Corporation shall not automatically affect such individual's employee status with the Corporation.

Section 4. President. The President shall preside or appoint a designee to preside at meetings of the Board of Directors. Unless provided otherwise by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, the President shall have general active management of the business of the Corporation, shall see that all orders and resolutions of the Board of Directors are carried into effect, shall sign and deliver in the name of the Corporation any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments pertaining to the business of the Corporation, except in cases in which the authority to sign and deliver is required by law to be exercised by another person or is expressly delegated by the Articles, these Bylaws, or the Board of Directors to some other officer or agent of the Corporation, may maintain records of and certify proceedings of the Board of Directors, and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Directors. The President shall have the general powers and duties generally vested in the office of a president of a nonprofit corporation and shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as the Board of Directors may prescribe from time to time.

Section 5. <u>Vice President</u>. The Vice President shall have such powers and perform such duties as the President or the Board of Directors may from time to time prescribe. In the absence of the President, or in the event of his or her death, inability or refusal to act, the Vice President shall perform the duties of the President and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all of the restrictions upon the President.

Section 6. Secretary. The Secretary shall be responsible for ensuring that all actions and the minutes of all proceedings of the Board of Directors are recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose, and shall be responsible for all documents and records of the Corporation, except those connected with the office of the Treasurer. He or she shall give or cause to be given any required notice of meetings of the Board of Directors, and shall mail to all Directors within thirty (30) days after each meeting copies of all said actions and minutes of said proceedings, and shall perform such other duties and have such other powers as the Board of Directors may from time to time prescribe.

Section 7. <u>Treasurer</u>. Unless provided otherwise by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall be chief financial officer of the Corporation; shall ensure accurate financial records for the Corporation are kept; shall ensure that all moneys, drafts, and checks in the name of and to the credit of the Corporation are deposited in such banks and depositories as the Board of Directors shall designate from time to time; shall ensure that all notes, checks, and drafts received by the Corporation as ordered by the Board of Directors are

endorsed for deposit, making proper vouchers therefore; shall oversee the disbursement of corporate funds and checks and drafts in the name of the Corporation as ordered by the Board of Directors; shall render to the President and the Board of Directors, whenever requested, an account of all such officer's transactions as Treasurer and of the financial condition of the Corporation; and shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors or the President from time to time. The Board of Directors may delegate the responsibilities of the Treasurer to one or more employees of the Corporation, provided, however, that such individual(s) shall be subject to the oversight and control of the Treasurer. The Treasurer shall at all times retain the ultimate responsibility for the financial affairs of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI

Committees

Section 1. Committees. The Board of Directors may establish one or more committees, including an Executive Committee, as may be specified in resolutions approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Directors in office. Such committees shall have the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the business of the Corporation to the extent provided in resolutions approved by a majority of the Directors currently holding office. Such committees, however, shall at all times be subject to the direction and control of the Board of Directors. Committee members must be natural persons.

Section 2. <u>Ex Officio Member</u>. The President, or representative appointed by the President, shall be an *ex officio* member, with voting rights, of each committee of the Corporation.

Section 3. <u>Committee Procedures</u>. The provisions of these Bylaws shall apply to committees and members thereof to the same extent they apply to the Board of Directors and Directors, including, without limitation, the provisions with respect to meetings and notice thereof, absent members, written actions and valid acts. Each committee shall keep regular minutes of its proceedings and report the same to the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII

Fiscal Matters

Section 1. Accounting Year. The accounting year of the Corporation shall be the calendar year.

Section 2. Contracts. The Board of Directors may authorize such officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be either general or confined to specific instances. Contracts and other instruments entered into in the ordinary course of business may be executed by the President or, in the absence of the President or pursuant to a delegation by the President, by such officer designated to act in the place of or in the absence of the President, without specific Board of Directors authorization.

- Section 3. Loans. No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the Corporation, and no evidence of indebtedness other than checks, drafts or other orders for payment of money issued in the ordinary course of business shall be issued in its name unless authorized by the Board of Directors of the Corporation. Such authorization and approval may be general or confined to specific instances.
- Section 4. Checks, Drafts, Etc. All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money issued in the name of the Corporation shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the Corporation and in such manner as shall be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors or by the President or Treasurer upon delegation by the Board of Directors.
- Section 5. <u>Deposits</u>. All funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors or the President or Treasurer upon delegation by the Board of Directors may select.
- Section 6. Maintenance of Records: Audit. The Corporation shall keep at its registered office correct and complete copies of its Articles and Bylaws, accounting records, voting agreements, and minutes of meetings of the Board of Directors, and committees having any of the authority of the Board of Directors for the last six (6) years. All such other records shall be open to inspection upon the demand of any member of the Board of Directors of the Corporation. The Board of Directors shall cause the books and records of account of the Corporation to be audited by certified public accountants, to be selected by the Board of Directors, at such times as it may deem necessary or appropriate.

Section 7. Corporate Seal. The Corporation shall have no corporate seal.

ARTICLE VIII

Indemnification

- Section 1. <u>Indemnification of Disqualified Persons</u>. In connection with any judicial proceeding, whether civil or criminal, or any administrative proceeding, including, but not limited to, any judicial or administrative proceedings involving Chapter 42 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") or state laws relating to mismanagement of funds of charitable organizations, the Corporation may indemnify a "disqualified person" with respect to the Corporation within the meaning of Section 4946 of the Code ("Disqualified Person") only against all expenses (other than taxes, penalties, or expenses of correction), including attorney's fees, sustained in connection with the defense of any such proceeding only if:
 - (a) such expenses are reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such proceeding, and

(b) he or she is successful in such defense, or such proceeding is terminated by settlement, and he or she has not acted willfully and without reasonable cause with respect to the act or failure to act which gave rise to the proceeding with respect to which such expenses were incurred.

Any indemnification available under this Section shall be limited to suits or actions brought against the individual in his/her capacity as an officer, Director, employee or agent of the Corporation. The Corporation may not indemnify a person who is a Disqualified Person against judgments, fines, taxes, expenses of correction, and amounts paid in settlement with respect to any judicial proceedings, whether civil or criminal or any administrative proceedings, including, but not limited to, any judicial or administrative proceedings involving Chapter 42 of the Code or state laws relating to mismanagement of funds of charitable organizations.

Section 2. <u>Liability Insurance</u>. The Corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a Director, officer, employee or agent of the Corporation, or who is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a Director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against any liability asserted against such person and incurred by such person in any such capacity, or arising out of his or her status as such, whether or not the Corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such liability under the provisions of this Article, provided that each Disqualified Person's share of the premium for an insurance policy which covers amounts the indemnification of which directly by the Corporation would constitute an act or acts of self-dealing within the meaning of Section 4941 of the Code and the regulations thereunder shall be treated as compensation paid to such Disqualified Person, and further provided, that such share of such premium shall be paid by the Corporation only if such payment would not cause the total compensation paid to such Disqualified Person by the Corporation to be unreasonable or excessive.

ARTICLE IX

Director Conflict of Interest

Section 1. <u>Policy</u>. It shall be the policy of the Corporation that it shall not engage in any activities that would constitute self-dealing under the Code. In addition, it is the policy of the Corporation that all interested persons shall scrupulously avoid any conflict between their own respective individual interests and the interests of the Corporation in any and all actions taken by them on behalf of the Corporation in their representative capacities. No interested person of the Corporation shall use his or her position in a manner that may create a conflict between personal interests and those of the Corporation or related entity, or otherwise engage in actions that may create a conflict of interest. Interested persons shall comply with all governmental statutes, ordinances and regulations, including those relating to conflicts of interest. "Interested person" means Directors, officers, and substantial contributors to, the Corporation.

Section 2. <u>Definition of Conflict of Interest</u>. A conflict of interest exists when any interested person of the Corporation has a direct or indirect interest in or a relationship with any individual or organization which proposes to enter into any transaction with the Corporation for

the sale, purchase, lease or rental of property, or the loan of money, or to render or employ services, personal or otherwise.

Section 3. <u>Interests or Relationships</u>. The following are considered direct or indirect interests or relationships which would trigger this Conflict of Interest Policy. As a result, the requirements of Section 4 must be met if the Corporation is contemplating a transaction described in Section 2 with any of the following:

- a. an interested person of the Corporation, or a member of the family of an interested person of the Corporation (for purposes of this Section 3, a member of the family is a spouse, parent, child, spouse of a child, brother, sister, or spouse of a brother or sister);
- b. a Director or trustee of a related organization, or a member of the family of a Director or trustee of a related organization;
- c. an organization in which an interested person of the Corporation, or a member of the family of an interested person, is a Director, officer, trustee, or legal representative; or
- d. an organization in which an interested person of the Corporation, or a member of the family of an interested person, has a material financial interest.

Section 4. <u>Procedures</u>. The Corporation may enter into a transaction involving a conflict of interest if it has determined the transaction would not constitute self-dealing under the Code and if all of the following are true:

- a. Fairness and Reasonableness: The contract or transaction was fair and reasonable to the Corporation. Whether a contract or transaction is fair and reasonable to the Corporation will be determined by looking to the time the contract or transaction was authorized, approved or ratified. The party asserting the validity of the contract or transaction has the burden of establishing the contract's or transaction's fairness and reasonableness to the Corporation.
- b. **Disclosure of Material Facts to Board**: The material facts about both the contract or transaction and the interested person's interest in the contract or transaction are either fully disclosed or known to the Board of Directors or a committee of the Corporation.
- c. Approval by Board: The contract or transaction must be authorized, ratified, or approved in good faith by a majority of the Board of Directors or committee of the Board of Directors. The vote of any interested Director does not count for purpose of determining what constitutes a majority vote, and the presence of any interested Director at a meeting at

which such a vote is taken does not count in determining the presence of a quorum.

If Section 4 is satisfied, the interested person of the Corporation may be a party to the contract or transaction and may be present at the meeting at which the contract or transaction was authorized, approved, or ratified, but may not vote on approving such transaction.

Section 5. <u>Publication of Policy</u>. A copy of this statement shall be furnished to each officer, Director, and committee member or executive who is presently serving the Corporation or who may hereafter become associated with the Corporation. This policy shall be called to the attention of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, at least annually at a regular meeting thereof, and such action shall be recorded in the minutes of such meeting. Each Director, officer, and committee member of the Corporation shall annually complete a Disclosure Statement and submit such statement to the Secretary of the Corporation for filing in the Corporation's minute book.

ARTICLE X

Plan of Grantmaking

- Section 1. <u>Family Groups</u>. Each member of the Board of Directors shall have a corresponding family group (each, a "Family Group") that will represent the interests of that family branch in the Corporation's grantmaking process. Each Director shall appoint individuals to serve as members of his or her Family Group, and may appoint and remove members of the Family Group at the Director's discretion.
- Section 2. Grantmaking Process. Each Family Group will meet [quarterly/annually] and will make an initial determination of the grant recipients and grant amounts that such Family Group would like the Corporation to distribute that year, based on the distribution amount allocated to that Family Group as described in Section 3. The Family Group will submit its grantmaking recommendations to the Board of Directors, which will make a final determination regarding the grants distributed by the Corporation.
- Section 3. Allocation of Distribution. Today we agree that distributions of the Corporation will be divided evenly between the Family Groups that correspond to the four members of the Corporation's Board of Directors as of 2012. If in the future a Family Group makes an additional contribution to the Corporation, the intent is that such contribution will be taken into account in allocating the Corporation's total annual distribution amount among the Family Groups. The Board of Directors will establish by resolution any such adjustments to the allocation of the distribution amount among the Family Groups.

ARTICLE XI

Amendments

The Corporation's Articles of Incorporation and these Bylaws may be altered, amended or restated by the Board of Directors to omit or include any provision which could be lawfully omitted or included at the time of such amendment. Any number of amendments, or an entire revision or restatement of the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws, may be voted upon at a meeting of the Board of Directors or by action in writing where due notice of the proposed amendment has been given and shall be adopted upon the affirmative vote of a majority of all Directors entitled to vote on the proposed amendment or revision.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT AMENDING AND RESTATING THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE RODMAN FOUNDATION

The Rodman Foundation, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation (the "Corporation"), acting through its Secretary, hereby files these Articles of Amendment amending and restating its Articles of Incorporation by replacing them in their entirety with the following:

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the Corporation is The Rodman Foundation.

ARTICLE II

Purposes and Activities

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes within the meaning of Sections 501(c)(3), 170(c)(2), 2055(a) and 2522(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("the Code"). Within the limitations established by the preceding sentence, the Corporation is organized and shall be operated primarily to support the relief of poverty, the advancement of education, the advancement of religion and other purposes beneficial to the community, to make grants and contributions to organizations which are exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a) of the Code by virtue of being described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and do any and all other acts and things and exercise any and all other rights and powers which may be reasonably necessary, incidental, desirable or expedient in the accomplishment of such purposes.

ARTICLE III

Powers

The Corporation shall have those powers which are required by, and are consistent with, the purposes enumerated in Article II above. Within those limitations, the Corporation may act on its own behalf or as the agent, trustee or representative of others; acquire or receive property of every kind by any legal means; hold, manage, use and dispose of any property and the income generated by it to further any of the purposes of the Corporation; lease, mortgage or encumber any such property; and exercise any other powers conferred on the Corporation by Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A.

ARTICLE IV

Restrictions

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation ("Articles"), the restrictions in this Article IV shall govern the activities of the Corporation.

The Corporation shall not engage in any activity which may not be carried on (a) by an organization which is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a) of the Code by virtue of being described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or (b) by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a) and 2522(a) of the Code.

The Corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its Directors or officers, and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and goods received, to provide indemnification and pay premiums for insurance protection without reimbursement to the full extent permitted or required by applicable law, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II of these Articles.

The Corporation shall not attempt to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise. The Corporation shall neither directly nor indirectly participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office, whether by the publishing or distributing of statements or otherwise.

The Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner so as not to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4942 of the Code. The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code, retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code, make any investments in such manner as to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, or make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.

The Corporation shall not lend money to or guaranty the obligation of a director, officer, or employee of the Corporation or related organization, or of the spouse, parents, children and spouses of children, brothers and sisters or spouses of brothers and sisters of the director, officer, or employee.

ARTICLE V

Registered Office

The Corporation's registered office in the state shall be located at 30 East 7th Street, Suite 2000, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101.

ARTICLE VI

Board of Directors

The management and direction of the business and affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors. To the extent consistent with these Articles and permissible under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A, the Bylaws of the Corporation shall specify the number or the manner for determining the number, term of office, method of selection, powers and duties

of the Directors of the Corporation, the time and place of their meetings, voting rights, and such other regulations pertaining to the Board of Directors as are deemed necessary. An action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken by written action signed by the number of Directors that would be required or permitted to take such action at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which all Directors were present.

ARTICLE VII

Membership

The Corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE VIII

No Personal Liability

The officers and Directors of the Corporation shall not be personally liable for the payment of any debts or obligations of the Corporation, nor shall any property of any officer or director be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

No Capital Stock

The Corporation shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE X

Amendments

These Articles may be amended as set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XI

Dissolution

The Corporation may be dissolved in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board or the officers acting under the direction of the Board, shall distribute the assets of the Corporation in the following order of priority: (1) assets

received and held for a special use or purpose in accordance with the uses and purposes for which the assets have been received and held; (2) costs and expenses of the dissolution proceedings, including attorney fees and disbursements; and (3) debts, obligations, and liabilities of the Corporation. Any property remaining after these payments shall be transferred, in such proportions as the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall determine, to one or more organizations which are exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a) by virtue of being described in Code Section 501(c)(3) exclusively for exempt purposes within the meaning of Code Section 501(c)(3), or to the State of Minnesota or any political subdivision or agency of the State for exclusively public purposes. No provision of these Articles shall be construed to affect the disposition of property held by the Corporation upon trust or other condition, and upon dissolution of the Corporation, such property shall be transferred in accordance with the trust or condition imposed with respect to it.

The foregoing Articles of Amendment Amending and Restating the Articles of Incorporation of The Rodman Foundation have been adopted by the Corporation's Board of Directors and Members pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A, and shall be effective when filed with the Office of the Secretary of State.
