The mission of the Foundation is to financially support organizations that help children, adults, and seniors in need to obtain physical and mental health care and related human services in the Philadelphia area.

The Foundation is interested in encouraging practical solutions to community problems and supporting preventive and direct service efforts within its chosen fields. The Patricia Kind Family Foundation operates no programs of its own, but performs its mission by supporting and stimulating innovative and creative approaches to health and human services from appropriate agencies and institutions in the Delaware Valley area. Priority will be given to smaller organizations with the potential to make a difference.

All applicants must include a cover sheet with their grant proposal. This can be downloaded from our website (www.PKFFoundation.net) or by visiting the Delaware Valley Grantmakers' website (www.dvg.org). Along with the cover sheet, you may include a brief letter summarizing the grant request, including the objectives and significance of the program and the specific amount of money requested. The proposal itself should not exceed five pages. It should include a detailed description of the program design and proposed accomplishments during the grant period. In addition to the 5 page proposal, a statement of the qualifications of personnel and the capabilities of the organization to carry out the proposed project; a budget detailing all planned expenditures, anticipated income, sources of income; and plans for future fundraising for the project, if applicable, are necessary. Additional documentation must include a copy of the Internal Revenue Service letter indicating tax-exempt status. The most recent financial statement, a current operating budget, and a list of directors and officers of the organization also need to be included. Please send only the materials requested. Additional materials will be discarded. Do not mail your proposal with a request for a signature receipt (Certified, Fedex, etc.). If you would like confirmation of receipt, include a stamped, self-addressed envelope or postcard with your application.

The Board meets in January, April and August to consider funding requests. Because of the consistently large volume, most proposals are received 4-6 months before they are evaluated fully and placed on our meeting agenda. Most giving is in the range of \$5,000 to \$25,000/year for a one to three year period. Priority will be given to smaller organizations with general operating budgets under \$1 million dollars and who provide direct services to the underserved in our community. Successful applicants will be notified in writing of the action of the Board. Foundation grants are made only to non-profit, charitable organizations that are tax-exempt under Section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Board will not discuss funding options with potential grantees prior to receipt of a complete grant request. Please review our guidelines and past Annual Reports to determine if your program meets our requirements.

Submission postmark deadlines:

August 1 for review at January meeting

December 1 for review at April meeting

April 1 for review at August meeting

Grantees are required to submit reports reflecting progress towards stated objectives and to notify the Foundation at any time if there is a major change or delay in the proposed plans. A grant year-end report assessing accomplishment of stated objectives of the grant and a financial accounting is necessary. When a multi-year grant is approved payment of subsequent installments is made conditional on the satisfaction of the Foundation with progress under the grant. Grantees must wait at least one year after the completion of a grant before reapplying for support.

Excluded from the Foundation's funding priorities are grants in direct support of individuals, i.e., scholarships or fellowships; endowments; capital projects; support of international activities or international institutions; and research.
