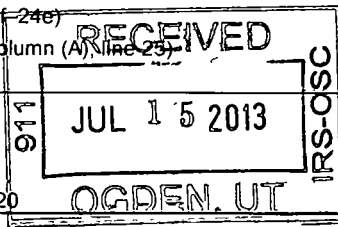

Sample curriculum for the Adult Jail Chaplaincy Training includes: the role of a chaplain; how to deliver a death notification; grief intervention; overview of the criminal justice system; listening skills; suicide awareness; criminal thinking errors and addiction and substance abuse.

AJC program provided a chaplaincy presence within the Hamilton County jail facilities throughout 2012. It is estimated that this involved 1500 hours of volunteered time consisting of a mix of crisis intervention and regular one to one visitation with prisoner and corrections staff.
