SECONDLY, AFTER THE GRANT AGREEMENT HAS BEEN SIGNED, SAEM FOUNDATION
REQUIRES INTERIM PROGRESS REPORTS AND FINAL REPORTS AT KEY INTERVALS DURING
THE GRANT PERIOD (USUALLY 6, 12, AND 24 MONTHS) FROM THE PRINCIPAL
INVESTIGATOR ON THE PROJECT, AS WELL AS FINANCIAL REPORTS FROM THE
INSTITUTION, TO SHOW HOW THE GRANT FUNDS ARE BEING USED. THE CHAIR OF THE
SAEM FOUNDATION GRANTS COMMITTEE REVIEWS ALL PROGRESS REPORTS AND INFORMS
THE SAEM FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS IF A PROBLEM IS IDENTIFIED. IN THE
GRANT AGREEMENT, SAEM FOUNDATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TERMINATE A GRANT IF
IT IS DECIDED THAT THE FUNDS ARE BEING USED INAPPROPRIATELY. SAEM
FOUNDATION ALSO RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CONDUCT SITE VISITS TO THE
INSTITUTION AT ANY TIME.

FINALLY, SAEM FOUNDATION KEEPS RECORD OF ALL PROGRESS REPORTS AND FINAL
REPORTS IN BOTH ELECTRONIC AND HARD COPY FORMATS. IF A PARTICULAR
INDIVIDUAL OR INSTITUTION IS CONSISTENTLY LATE ON TURNING IN REQUIRED
REPORTS, OR HAS NOT MET THE RESPONSIBILITIES OUTLINED IN THE GRANT
AGREEMENT, SAEM FOUNDATION WILL KEEP A RECORD OF THEIR HISTORY AND TAKE
THAT INFORMATION INTO CONSIDERATION IF ANOTHER APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED TO
SAEM FOUNDATION IN THE FUTURE.

SAEM FOUNDATION HOPES TO CONTINUE TO IMPROVE ITS GRANTMAKING PROCESS OVER
TIME, AND WILL CONTINUE TO EVALUATE AND MONITOR THE USE OF GRANT FUNDS TO
ALL RECIPIENTS.
