BYLAWS BFRIN

The Bylaws set forth herein on this 1st day of January 2013 are to replace, it their entirety, the Bylaws adopted by BFRIN (formerly known as Bereaved Families Relief Initiative Network) on the 11th day of August 2011

ARTICLE I NAME AND PURPOSE

Section 1.01. Name. The name of the organization is BFRIN.

Section 1.02. Purpose. The Corporation is organized for the charitable purpose of providing support to those affected by breast cancer.

ARTICLE II MEMBERS

Section 2.01. Classes. There shall be two classes of members: Corporate and Individual

Section 202. Qualifications. Membership may be granted to any individual or corporation that wholeheartedly supports the mission and purposes of the organization. Members have no voting rights.

Section 2.03. Termination of Membership. The Board of Directors, comprising of the President, Executive Director, and Treasurer – by affirmative vote of two-thirds, may expel a member and may terminate the membership of any member who becomes ineligible for membership.

Section 2.04. Resignation. Any member may resign by filing a written resignation with the Executive Director.

Section 2.05. Dues. No dues for members shall be established by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE III AUTHORITY AND DUTIES OF DIRECTORS

Section 3.01. Authority of Directors. The Board of Directors - also known as the Board, is the policy-making body and may exercise the powers and authority granted to the Corporation by law.

Section 3.02. Number and Selection. The Board of Directors shall consist of the President, one (1) Executive Director and (1) Treasurer. The President will elect any successors.

Section 3.03. Resignation and Removal. Resignations are effective through written notification upon receipt by the President of the Corporation. Removal from office of any person on the Board of Directors may be made by two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors.

Section 3.04. Regular Meetings. The Board of Directors shall hold at least two (2) regular meetings per calendar year. Meetings shall be at such dates, times and places as the Board shall determine.

Section 3.05. Special Meetings. Special meetings shall be at such dates, times and places as the Board shall determine.

Section 3.06. Notice. Meetings may be called by the President by notice: emailed, mailed or telephoned to each member of the Board not less than twenty-four (24) hours before such meeting.

Section 3.07. Action Without a Meeting. Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors (including amendment of these Bylaws) may be taken without a meeting if all the members of the Board consent in writing to taking the action without meeting and to approving the specific action. Such consents shall have the same force and effect as a unanimous vote of the Board or of the committee as the case may be.

Section 3.08. Participation in Meeting by Conference Telephone. Members of the Board may participate in a meeting through use of conference telephone or similar communications equipment, so long as members participating in such meeting can hear one another.

Section 3.09. Compensation. Directors serving the organization are allowed to receive compensation. Individuals who receive compensation will follow a conflict of interest policy as set forth in Article X. Compensation will be approved in advance of payment in writing, including the date and terms of approved compensation arrangements. President and Treasurer positions are not allowed to receive compensation.

ARTICLE IV

PAID STAFF and Board MEMBERS

Section 4.01. Paid Staff. The Board of Directors may hire such paid staff as they deem proper and necessary for the operations of the Corporation. The powers and duties of the paid staff shall be as assigned or as delegated to be assigned by the Board.

Section 4.02. Board Members. Board Members are not to receive compensation for their participation in the activities of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V INDEMNIFICATION

Every member of the Board of Directors, officer or employee of the Corporation may be indemnified by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred or imposed upon such members of the Board, officer or employee in connection with any threatened, pending, or completed action, suit or proceeding to which he/she may become involved by reason of his/her duties. Provided, however, that in the event of a settlement of the indemnification herein shall apply only when the Board approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the Corporation. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition and not exclusive of all other rights to which such member of the Board, officer or employee is entitled.

ARTICLE VI ADVISORY BOARD AND COMMITTEES

Section 6.01. Establishment. The Board of Directors may establish Advisory Boards or Committees.

Section 6.02. Size, Duration and Responsibilities. The size, duration, and responsibilities of such Boards and Committees shall be established by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION

Section 7.01. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall be January 1 – December 31, but may be changed by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 7.02. Checks, Drafts, Etc. All checks, orders for the payment of money, bills of lading, warehouse receipts, obligations, bills of exchange, and insurance certificates shall be signed or endorsed by such officer(s) or agent(s) of the Corporation.

Section 7.03. Deposits and Accounts. All funds of the Corporation, not otherwise employed, shall be deposited in such banks, trust companies, or other depositories as the Board of Directors or any committee to which such authority has been delegated by the Board may select, or as may be selected by any other officer(s) or agent(s) of the Corporation, to whom such power may be delegated by the Board. For the purpose of deposit and for the purpose of collection for that account of the Corporation, checks, drafts, and other orders of the Corporation may be endorsed, assigned and delivered on behalf of the Corporation by any officer or agent of the Corporation.

Section 7.04. Investments. The funds of the Corporation may be retained in whole or in part in cash or be invested and reinvested on occasion in such property, real, personal, or otherwise, or stock, bonds, or other securities, as the Board of Directors in its sole discretion may deem desirable, without regard to the limitations, if any, now imposed or which may hereafter be imposed by law regarding such investments, and which are permitted to organizations exempt from Federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VIII BOOKS AND RECORDS

Correct books of account of the activities and transactions of the Corporation shall be kept at the office of the Corporation. These shall include minutes, a copy of the Articles of Incorporation and a copy of Corporation Bylaws.

ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTION OF ORGANIZATION

Upon dissolution of the organization, such assets as remain shall be distributed for charitable, educational or scientific purposes as described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code or corresponding provision of said Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government; for a public purpose.

ARTICLE X CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

For each interest disclosed, monetary or otherwise, the full Board, or the President, as appropriate, will determine whether the organization should: (a) take no action and thus avoid the conflict or (b) disclose the situation more broadly and invite discussion/resolution by the full Board of what action to take. When the conflict involves a decision-maker, the person with the conflict ("interested party"): (i) must fully disclose the conflict to all other decision-makers; (ii) may not be involved in the decision of what action to take (e.g., may not participate in a vote) but may serve as a resource to provide other decision-makers with needed information.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST (continued)

- •In some cases the person with the conflict may be asked to exclude himself/herself from sensitive discussions so as not to unduly influence the discussion of the conflict.
- •In all cases, decisions involving a conflict will be made only by disinterested persons.
- •The fact that a conflict was managed and the outcome will be documented in the minutes of a Board Meeting if the conflict was related to a Board Member, and reported by the Executive Director if the conflict was related to a Member.
- •The Executive Director will monitor proposed or ongoing transactions of the organization (e.g., contracts with vendors and collaborations with third parties) for conflicts of interest and disclose them to the Board and staff, as appropriate, whether discovered before or after the transaction has occurred.

ARTICLE XI AMMENDMENT and RECONSTRUCTION of BYLAWS

These Bylaws may be amended and/or fully reconstructed by a majority vote of the Board of Directors or by unanimous consent in writing without a meeting pursuant to Section 3.08.
