#### Explanation

The Foundation made a distribution to a donor advised fund, the William and Ann Murphy Charitable Foundation, held at Fidelity Charitable, which the Foundation treated as a qualifying distribution. The distribution to the donor advised fund accomplishes the purposes described in Section 170(c)(2)(B) because all distributions from the donor advised fund must be made to IRS-qualified public charities.

Fidelity Charitable has issued Policy Guidelines in order to ensure that the funds are distributed to IRS qualified public charities. The policy guidelines provide that certain authorized advisors may make grant recommendations. However, the recommendations are non-binding and subject to review and approval of the Trustees of Fidelity Charitable.

In addition, Fidelity reserves the right to perform additional due diligence and to decline to make a recommended grant in situations such as where a person with advisory privileges may receive more than an incidental benefit or where such person with advisory privileges controls the charitable organization.

Further, Fidelity Charitable requires that minimum annual grants, on an overall basis, be greater than 5% of the average net assets on a fiscal five-year rolling basis. If this requirement is not met, then Fidelity will ask for a grant recommendation. If a recommendation is not made, then

Fidelity will transfer the required amounts to the Trustees' Philanthropic Fund and Fidelity will make grants at its discretion.

Fidelity Charitable has exclusive legal control over the assets of the donor advised fund and the contribution to the fund is irrevocable and cannot be refunded.
