ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is DAWAT-E-ISLAMI, INC.

ARTICLE II

ARTICLE V

The corporation will continue in perpetuity.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious purposes and not part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director or officer thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

ARTICLE VI

Except as these Articles otherwise provide, the corporation has all the powers provided in the California Non-Profit Corporation Law. Moreover, the corporation has all implied powers necessary and proper to carry out its express powers. The corporation may reasonably compensate directors or officers for services rendered to or for the corporation in furtherance of one or more of its purposes.

ARTICLE VII

The corporation may not pay dividends or other corporate income to its directors or officers, or otherwise accrue distributable profits, or permit the realization of private gain.

The corporation may not take any action prohibited by the California Non-Profit

Corporation Law. The corporation may not engage in any activities, except to an insubstantial degree, that do not further its purposes as set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized primarily and exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and the corporation may not take any action that would be inconsistent with the requirements for a tax exemption under the Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) and related regulations, ruling, and procedures, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws. Nor may it take any action that would be inconsistent with the requirements for receiving tax-deductible charitable contributions under Internal Revenue Code Section 170(c)(2) and related regulations, rulings, and procedures, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws. Regardless of any other provision in these Articles of Incorporation or state law, the corporation may not:

1. engage in activities or use its assets in manners that do not further one or more exempt purposes, as set forth in these Articles and defined by the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, rulings, and procedures, except to an insubstantial degree.
2. serve a private interest other than one clearly incidental to an overriding public interest.
3. devote more than an insubstantial part of its activities to attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise, except as provided by the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, rulings, and procedures.

4. participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. The prohibited activities include publishing or distributing statements and any other direct or indirect campaign activities.
5. distribute its assets on dissolution other than for one or more exempt purposes.
On dissolution, the corporation's assets will be distributed to the state government for a public purpose, or to an organization exempt from taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) to be used to accomplish the general purposes for which the corporation was organized.
6. permit any part of the corporation's net earnings to inure to the benefit of any director, officer of the corporation, affiliate or any private individual, and no director, officer of the corporation, affiliate, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.
7. carry on an unrelated trade or business, except as a necessary purpose related to the corporation's primary, exempt purposes.

ARTICLE VIII

The corporation shall have no members. The management of the corporation is vested in its Board of Directors and such committees of the Board that the Board may, from time-to-time, establish. The bylaws will provide the qualifications, manner of selection, duties, terms, and other matters relating to the Board of Directors.

The number of directors may be increased or decreased by adopting or amending the bylaws. The number of directors may not be decreased to fewer than five (5) or increased

to more than eleven (11). A minimum of three (3) directors is required to maintain the quorum.

ARTICLE IX

(a) For the purposes of this section, "agent" means any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or other agent of the corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee, or agent of another foreign or domestic corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise, or was a director, officer, employee, or agent of a foreign or domestic corporation which was a predecessor corporation of the corporation or of another enterprise at the request of such predecessor corporation; "proceeding" means any threatened, pending, or completed action or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative; and "expenses"

includes without limitation attorneys' fees and any expenses of establishing a right to indemnification under subdivision (d) or paragraph (3) of subdivision (e).

(b) A corporation shall have power to indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any proceeding (other than an action by or in the right of the corporation to procure a judgment in its favor, an action brought under Section 9243, or an action brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Section 9230) by reason of the fact that such person is or was an agent of the corporation, against expenses, judgments, fines, settlements and other amounts actually and reasonably incurred in connection with such proceeding if such person acted in good faith and in a manner such person believed to be in the best interests of the corporation and, in the case of a criminal proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe the conduct of such person was unlawful. The termination of any proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction or upon a plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent shall not, of itself, create a presumption that the person did not act in good faith and in a manner which the person believed to be in the best interests of the corporation or that the person had reasonable cause to believe that the person's conduct was unlawful.

(c) A corporation shall have power to indemnify any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action by or in the right of the corporation, or brought under Section 9243, or brought by the Attorney General pursuant to Section 9230, to procure a judgment in its favor by reason of the fact that such person is or was an agent of the corporation, against expenses actually and reasonably incurred by such person in connection with the defense or settlement of such

action if the person acted in good faith, in a manner in which such person believed to be in the best interests of the corporation and with such care, including reasonable inquiry, as an ordinary prudent person in a like position would use under similar circumstances.

No indemnification shall be made under this subdivision:

1. In respect of any claim, issue, or matter as to which such person shall have been adjudged to be liable to the corporation in the performance of such person's duty to the corporation, unless and only to the extent that the court in which such proceeding is or was pending shall determine upon application that, in view of all the circumstances of the case, such person is fairly and reasonably entitled to indemnity for the expenses which such court shall determine;
2. Of amounts paid in settling or otherwise disposing of a threatened or pending action, with or without court approval; or
3. Of expenses incurred in defending a threatened or pending action which is settled or otherwise disposed of without court approval unless it is settled with the approval of the Attorney General.

(d) To the extent that an agent of a corporation has been successful on the merits in defense of any proceeding referred to in subdivision (b) or (c) or in defense of any claim, issue or matter therein, the agent shall be indemnified against expenses actually and reasonably incurred by the agent in connection therewith.

(e) Except as provided in subdivision (d), any indemnification under this section shall be made by the corporation only if authorized in the specific case, upon a determination that indemnification of the agent is proper in the circumstances because the agent has met the applicable standard of conduct set forth in either subdivision (b) or (c) by:

1. A majority vote of a quorum consisting of directors who are not parties to such proceeding;
2. Approval of the members (Section 5034), with the persons to be indemnified not being entitled to vote thereon; or
3. The court in which such proceeding is or was pending upon application made by the corporation or the agent or the attorney or other person rendering services in connection with the defense, whether or not such application by the agent, attorney or other person is opposed by the corporation.

(f) Expenses incurred in defending any proceeding may be advanced by the corporation prior to the final disposition of such proceeding upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of the agent to repay such amount unless it shall be determined ultimately that the agent is entitled to be indemnified as authorized in this section.

(g) No provision made by a corporation to indemnify its or its subsidiary's directors or officers for the defense of any proceeding, whether contained in the articles, bylaws, a resolution of members or directors, an agreement or otherwise, shall be valid unless consistent with this section. Nothing contained in this section shall affect any right to indemnification to which persons other than such directors and officers may be entitled by contract or otherwise.

(h) No indemnification or advance shall be made under this section, except as provided in subdivision (d) or paragraph (3) of subdivision (e), in any circumstance where it appears that:

1. It would be inconsistent with a provision of the articles, bylaws, a resolution of the members or an agreement in effect at the time of the accrual of the alleged

cause of action asserted in the proceeding in which the expenses were incurred or other amounts were paid, which prohibits or otherwise limits indemnification; or

2. It would be inconsistent with any condition expressly imposed by a court in approving a settlement.

(i) A corporation shall have power to purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any agent of the corporation against any liability asserted against or incurred by the agent in such capacity or arising out of the agent's status as such whether or not the corporation would have the power to indemnify the agent against such liability under the provisions of this section; provided, however, that a corporation shall have no power to purchase and maintain such insurance to indemnify any agent of the corporation for a violation of Section 9243.

(j) This section does not apply to any proceeding against any trustee, investment manager or other fiduciary of an employee benefit plan in such person's capacity as such, even though such person may also be an agent as defined in subdivision (a) of the employer corporation. A corporation shall have power to indemnify such trustee, investment manager or other fiduciary to the extent permitted by subdivision (f) of Section 207.

ARTICLE X

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the

Internal Revenue Code 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the country in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE XI


A director of the corporation is not liable to the corporation for monetary damages for an act or omission in the director's capacity as director, except that this provision does not eliminate or limit such director's liability for:

1. a breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the corporation;
2. an act or omission not in good faith that constitutes a breach of duty of the director to the corporation, or an action or omission that involved intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of the law;
3. a transaction from which the director received an improper benefit whether or not the benefit resulted from an action taken within the scope of the director's office;
or
4. an act or omission for which the liability of the director is expressly provided for by an applicable statute.

ARTICLE XII

All references in these Articles to statutes, regulations, or other sources of legal authority refer to the authorities cited, or their successors, as they may be amended from time to time.





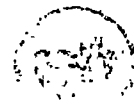
