THE ORGANIZATION HAS NOW TAKEN STEPS TO ENSURE THAT ALL OF ITS RETURNS WILL BE BROUGHT INTO COMPLIANCE, BOTH BEFORE AND AFTER THE MERGER, AND THAT SUCH LATE FILING DOES NOT OCCUR AGAIN.
