The Allen Foundation (the "Foundation") was formed on April 25, 2000, for the purpose of providing humanitarian and development aid to individuals in the most desperate areas of the world. To accomplish its charitable purposes, the Foundation began work in Cambodia, a country that has suffered almost unimaginable devastation and poverty for over three decades. Its projects in Cambodia were initiated under the supervision of Jacquelin Cochran, a project manager with graduate training through the Energy & Resources Department at the University of California at Berkeley where she specialized in the use of water purification and renewable energy technologies in South-East Asia.
- 2. Joint Venture with Stung Treng Women's Development Center (SWDC). As a continuation of its efforts in providing humanitarian and development aid in Cambodia, a joint venture in Cambodia's Stung Treng province was undertaken with Stung Treng Women's Development Center (SWDC) to reduce poverty by developing village-based sericulture which will enable local farmers to raise silkworms on mulberry trees, harvest and refine silk locally. This year the foundation committed an additional \$13,600 to this joint venture.

Between 2002 and 2012 SWDC has directly supported over 565 women, 792 children, 150 men, and directly assisted many families in the impoverished Stung Treng region of Cambodia. The SWDC programs now include:

Education Program in Literacy and Health Education Program School Sponsorship

Vocational Training in Traditional Weaving and Sewing

Vocational Training in Carpentry and Building

Vocational Training in Sericulture

Vocational Training in Retail Management, Accountancy, Design and Product Development, and Computer Skills

Employment at SWDC production center for Mekong Blue

Employment at SWDC café and gallery

Employment at SWDC Sericulture program

Free Lunch Program for workers

Construction of Community Children's Home

The March 2012 agreement with SWDC was funded with \$13,600. The purpose of the March 2012 agreement was to further assist and support the impoverished

population served by SWDC by assisting SWDC to obtain financial self-sufficiency through increased awareness and sales of its silk products in the Cambodian and international markets through their Phnom Penh store. The store was set up in 2009. In 2009 Mekong Blue also launched its first online store in the US. Mekong Blue was invited to display products and sell at the conference of Asian Leaders Meeting in October, 2012 and was also selected to attend the Folk Art Market in Santa Fe, New Mexico, a unique market that only selected Artists who make traditional and high quality products to support their own community. Mekong Blue has also been invited back to speak and display at events organized by U.S. and Australian Embassies and a Women's International Group.

Additionally, the March 2012 agreement provides support to carry out networking engagements and capitalize on new contracts with governments, NGO's, tourist industry, designers/technicians, suppliers and potential buyers. The addition of a sales manager has increased control over stock inventory and monitoring of order shipments. The agreement also includes amounts requested to be used in the mission of increasing the overall health of the community members by providing housing and transportation for children from Stung Treng who require medical attention in Phnom Penh.
