Nine winners will take an expense-paid trip to Japan, Korea and China before the competition. The trip combines journalism education with opportunities to learn about history, culture and modern life.

Roy W. Howard was a pioneer in international reporting, working in Japan, Korea and China before leading United Press International and Scripps Howard Newspapers.

Howard lived a global life well before most journalism schools taught international reporting. During a career spanning nearly six decades, he corresponded with presidents about U.S. policy in Asia, and records at the presidential libraries show they took his insight seriously.

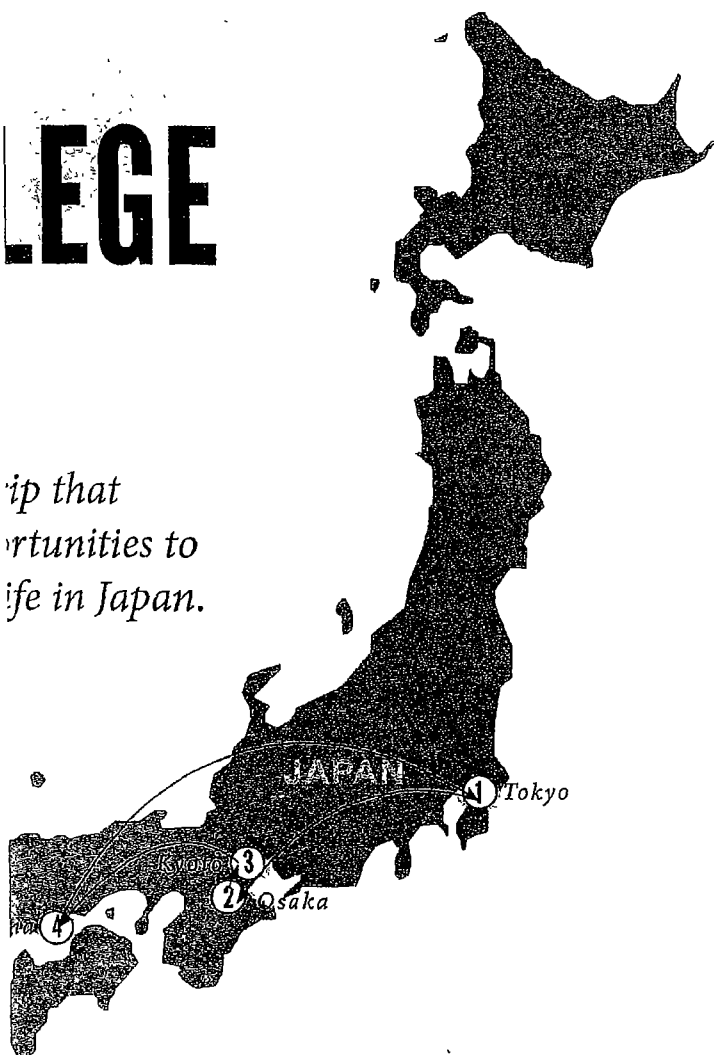
He was so revered by fellow journalists that in 1955, at 72, the Society of Professional Journalists named him honorary president. At the time of his death in 1963, then U.S. president Lyndon B. Johnson said he was "already a legend in his profession" and predicted he would be remembered in history as one of journalism's commanding figures.

The trip will combine journalism education with opportunities to learn about culture. Roy W. Howard scholar Bradley J. Hamm, dean of the Indiana University School of Journalism and an authority on Asian media, will lead the trip.



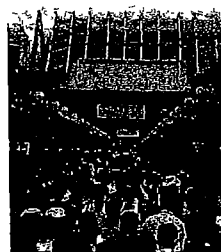

1 Tokyo

In Tokyo, you'll meet with professional journalists and see the latest in new media technology. You'll also visit one of the largest newspapers in the world and tour the grounds of the Imperial Palace, home of the Japanese emperor.



2 Osaka

After a ride on a Japanese bullet train, you'll visit Mainichi Broadcasting System in Osaka to meet with reporters and experiment with the newsroom's set. You'll also take time to visit historic landmarks, such as a 16th-century castle.



3 Kyoto

You'll take a break from touring newsrooms and busy streets to see Kyoto's religious landmarks. You'll take in the tranquil Golden Pavilion in a Buddhist temple and remove your shoes at the Zen rock gardens at the Ryoan temple.

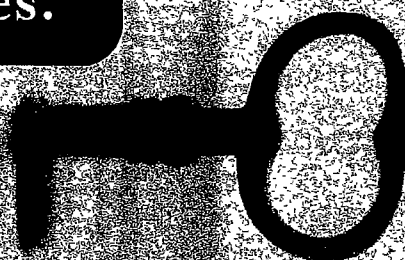

2013 National Merit Scholarship Program

For high school junior (11th grade/third year) students who will be completing or leaving high school and entering college in the fall of 2013.*

Scripps Howard Foundation established this scholarship program for sons and daughters of Scripps employees. The annual competition is conducted through the National Merit Scholarship Program by National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC), an independent, not-for-profit organization. NMSC's purposes are (1) to identify and honor exceptionally able high school students and (2) to provide a system of services for corporations, foundations, and other organizations that wish to sponsor college undergraduate scholarships for outstanding students who interest them. All aspects of the selection of winners and the administration of their awards are handled by NMSC.

Who is eligible?

Only high school students who are sons and daughters of Scripps employees can compete for these scholarships. Such students also must meet all requirements for participation in the National Merit Scholarship Program that are published in the *Official Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT* which is updated annually and distributed to students through their high schools.

To participate in the program, students must take the qualifying test, the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) during the proper high school year. In general, students who spend the usual four years in grades 9 through 12 must take the PSAT/NMSQT when they are in their third year (grade 11/junior year). A participant also must be a citizen of the United States; or be a U.S. lawful permanent resident (or have applied for permanent residence, the application for which has not been denied) and intend to become a U.S. citizen at the earliest opportunity allowed by law. The *Official Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT* explains these and other requirements for the competition, gives detailed information about the test (including sample questions and a complete practice test), and describes the scholarship programs NMSC administers.

* Students who plan to leave high school a year (or more) early to enroll in college full time should refer to the *Official Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT* (or contact NMSC) about when to take the qualifying test.

How do you enter?

To enter the competition for Scripps Howard Foundation Scholarships to be awarded in the spring of 2013:

1. A 2013 National Merit Scholarship Program Entry Form must be completed and submitted by December 31, 2011. An Entry Form for the 2013 competition is attached. Forms must be completed and mailed to: Vickie Martin, Scripps Howard Foundation, P.O. Box 5380, Cincinnati, OH 45201. Or the student may choose to complete and submit an Entry Form online at www.scripps.com/foundation under the Employee Programs section.
2. The student must take the PSAT/NMSQT in the fall of 2011, on the date their school chooses for the administration -- either Wednesday, October 12 or Saturday, October 15, 2011. At the beginning of the 2011-2012 school year, the student should obtain a copy of the *2011 Official Student Guide to the PSAT/NMSQT* from the high school counselor and make arrangements with the school to take the PSAT/NMSQT in October.

Important information regarding the PSAT/NMSQT:

- The 2011 PSAT/NMSQT is the qualifying test to enter the 2013 competition. Scores from prior PSAT/NMSQT administrations (2010 or earlier) cannot be used for participation in the 2013 program.
- The 2011 PSAT/NMSQT will be administered on Wednesday, October 12 or Saturday, October 15.
- The 2013 National Merit Scholarship Program Entry Form can be submitted prior to the student taking the October 2011 PSAT/NMSQT and/or receiving his/her official score report.
- As a sponsor of the examination, NMSC receives all 2011 PSAT/NMSQT scores and information students provide on their answer sheets. Therefore, students do not need to report their PSAT/NMSQT scores to NMSC.
- For more information about the PSAT/NMSQT or the National Merit Scholarship Program, visit NMSC's Web site at www.nationalmerit.org

NOTE: A student who does not take the 2011 PSAT/NMSQT because of illness, an emergency, or other extenuating circumstances (but meets all other participation requirements) may still be able to enter the 2013 competition. To request information about possible arrangements for alternate testing, the student must write directly to NMSC as soon as possible after the October 2011 PSAT/NMSQT administration but no later than March 1, 2012. The student should not delay; the earlier the student writes, the more options there are for scheduling test dates. The letter must be postmarked on or before March 1, 2012 for the request to be considered. How are winners selected?

All Scripps Howard Foundation Scholarship winners in 2013 will be chosen from a group of candidates who (1) score high on the 2011 PSAT/NMSQT and (2) are notified by NMSC in the fall of 2012 that they may receive further consideration for a scholarship by meeting several academic and other requirements set by NMSC. Scores from the 2011 PSAT/NMSQT will be used by NMSC as an initial

screen of applicants in the 2013 Scripps Howard Foundation Scholarship Program. **Entrants who advance in the competition will be contacted by NMSC on or before December 31, 2012.** (Only those entrants who advance in the competition will be notified and receive materials from NMSC.) These students and their high school principals will complete applications that include biographical and academic information that must be filed with NMSC. Scholarship winners will be chosen on a competitive basis and without regard to family financial circumstances, gender, race, ethnic origin, or religious preference. An NMSC committee of professionals trained in selection will choose the winners by evaluating several factors about each eligible candidate; these include academic record throughout high school, significant activities and contributions to the school and community, test scores, the school's recommendation of the candidate, and the student's essay about personal characteristics, activities, plans, and goals. In most cases, winners will be notified by NMSC in March of 2013. All winners are notified directly, prior to any public announcement that may be made about recipients.

What is the amount of the award?

Each Scripps Howard Foundation Scholarship stipend is \$2,000 per year for up to four years of college undergraduate study or until baccalaureate degree requirements are completed, whichever occurs first. The winner's annual stipend will not be affected by other scholarship aid or by an approved change in college.

Are there requirements that scholarship winners must meet?

Yes. The formal Scripps Howard Foundation Scholarship offer that NMSC sends to each winner specifies terms for acceptance and continuation of the award. A winner must enter college in the fall term following selection and must enroll as a full-time undergraduate in a college or university in the United States that holds accredited status with a regional accrediting commission on higher education. (Scholarship stipends are not payable for attendance at service academies, virtual universities, and certain institutions that are limited in their purposes or training.) Also, the winner must attend college during the day, enroll in a course of study leading to one of the traditional baccalaureate degrees, and remain in good academic and disciplinary standing.

Who handles scholarship procedures?

All phases of the competition, including the selection of winners and payment of scholarship stipends are handled for Scripps Howard Foundation by National Merit Scholarship Corporation.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR GREATER CINCINNATI FUND AND COMMUNITY FUND

Priority is given to projects and programs that make our communities better places to live, learn and work; that are measurable with stated goals and objectives; that clearly demonstrate effectiveness and innovation; that are models for others; that can eventually be self-supporting or show other evidence of long-term viability. All grant recipients must provide proof of 501(c)(3) status.

Specific projects and programs are preferred over general operating funds and capital campaigns.

Multi-year contributions and the purchase of tables at fund-raising events are discouraged.

The demand for support for special fundraising events far exceeds our ability to participate. We do not support walks, runs, golf outings or neighborhood-specific events. The exception is team sponsorship when employees are personally participating. We do not support "disease-related" events or those strictly related to research. We will not purchase tables for public or private K-12 schools, school districts or their foundations.

Organizations that receive United Way or Fine Arts or other general campaign funds, already supported by the Foundation, do not receive priority for funding.

The Foundation does not make contributions to individuals, to religious organizations (unless they are engaged in a significant program benefiting the entire community), to political causes or candidates, to anti-business organizations, for courtesy advertising, to organizations that discriminate on the basis of race, creed, religion, gender or national origin, to private foundations or to veterans, fraternal or labor groups.

WRITTEN REQUESTS ARE REQUIRED. Queries in advance of full proposal are advised. A full proposal includes a brief description of the organization, a brief description of the program for which support is requested, including rationale, a detailed project budget, schedule of implementation, methods of evaluating and reporting results, and qualifications of program manager. Describe other sources of funding. Include a recent financial statement and a list of the names and affiliations of the board of directors or other governing body.

Requests are accepted year-round. Notification is normally sent within 90 days.
