As of December 31, 2008, \$23,500 of the grant had been paid directly by grantor for the benefit of the grantee for the purposes of funding the conference on law and economics held in Fall, 2008. As of December 31, 2010, \$74,495.85 of the grant was yet to be funded.

During 2011, the entire amount of the original grant was paid to, or on behalf, of Grantee as follows:

In 2011, Grantor (i) paid \$25,516.61 directly to the vendor for the purchase of computers, printers and projectors for use in the research center on law and economic development and (ii) expended \$16,892.25 to purchase and ship to grantee books and research materials for the research center on law and economic development.

In 2011, Grantor paid directly to Grantee the sum of \$23,776 to support the publication of the Journal of Ethiopian Law. The amount expended by the Grantee towards the accomplishment of this purpose during 2012 is \$4,684.10 based on the report dated July 3, 2013 from the Grantee. The remaining unexpended grant funds for the publication of the Journal of Ethiopian Law are \$18,835.50 (taking into account effects of currency exchange changes).

In 2011, Grantor paid to Grantee (i) \$4,500 to fund research to be conducted by Professor Taddese, (ii) \$1,935 to fund research to be conducted by Professor Muradu and (iii) \$1,875 to fund research to be conducted by Professor Seyoum, in support of the research center on law and economic development.

The amount expended by the Grantee to fund the research of Professor Taddese is \$3,799.88 based on the report dated July 15, 2013 from the Grantee, leaving a remaining balance to be expended in connection with Professor Taddese's research of \$700.12.

The amount expended by the Grantee to fund the research of Professor Muradu is \$1,920.35 based on the report dated July 8, 2013 from the Grantee, leaving a remaining balance to be expended in connection with Professor Muradu's research of \$15.20.

The amount expended by the Grantee to fund the research of Professor Seyoum is \$1,875 based on the report dated July 5, 2013 from the Grantee, which fully utilizes the amount granted to provide funding for Professor Seyoum's research.

The DLA Piper Foundation will continue to monitor the use of the grant funds made for the publication of the *Journal of Ethiopian Law* and the use of grant funds made to support the work of Professors Taddese and Muradu.

To the best of the Grantor's knowledge, the Grantee has not diverted any portion of the grant funds (or any income therefrom) from the purpose of the grant.
